

## Directions to Locate Federal Prevailing Wage Rate Determinations

The most up-to-date wage determination must be in the covered contract.

Before a project is Let, there may be a change or modification of the wage determination. If a wage modification is issued 10 or more days prior to let, the modification needs to be included in the contract. If a wage modification is issued less than 10 days prior to let there would not be enough time to notify bidders and the modification do not need to be included. After the bids are opened, the wage determination remains in effect providing the contract is awarded within 90 days from the date of bid opening. If the wage rates are not correct in the contract, employees would be due back wages which the prime contractor or the sponsor would be responsible for.

## Construction Type

DBA: Construction Type (can include more than one construction type depending on the project):

- **Building Construction** includes the construction, rehabilitation and repair of sheltered enclosures with walk-in access for the purpose of housing persons, machinery, equipment, or supplies. **By county.**
- **Highway Construction** includes the construction, alteration or repair of roads, streets, highways, runways, parking areas and most other paving work not incidental to building or heavy construction. **WI 10.**
- **Heavy Construction** is a “catch-all” category which includes those projects which cannot be classified as Building, Residential or Highway; often further distinguished on the basis of the characteristics of particular projects, such as dredging, water and sewer line, dams, major bridges and flood control projects.

**Heavy WI 15 included in contract if there is a bridge or structure over a navigable waterway as defined by USDOL and the US Coast Guard (applies to all work on the bridge/structure from bank to bank).**

**Heavy WI08 included in contract if sanitary sewer and water main work is more than 20% of the contract and will cost more than 1 million.**

Print off the wage rates and include in contract prior to Let.

**Important: Eleven days prior to let, check to make sure a new wage determination has not been posted by US DOL. Go in to the website. Bring up the wage determination. Check the Modification # and the Last Revised Date. If there is a more current modification, that determination will have to be included in the bidding documents and all bidders will need to be notified.**

**If a modification is made 10 days or less before the let date the new wage determination does not have to be included because of not enough time to notify bidders.**

**If for some reason the contract is not awarded within 90 days of bid opening, prior to award the wage determination will need to be reviewed again to see if there was a modification.**
