U.S. Veteran Motorcycle plate

Who is eligible?

- ▶ An owner, lessee or trust beneficiary who is a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces.

No special parking privileges are provided with U.S. Veteran Motorcycle plates.

Vehicles that qualify

- ▶ U.S. Veteran Motorcycle plates are available for motorcycles only.

Fees needed

- ▶ A \$15 non-personalized issuance fee or the biennial personalized plate fee (\$30 in even years, \$15 in odd years).
- ▶ The \$23 biennial registration fee, if your current plates expire within 3 months.

Personalized plate information

- ▶ A \$30 personalized plate fee (biennial – every even year) is required in addition to the \$23 regular registration fee.
- ▶ WisDOT may refuse to issue or may recall after issuance a request that is misleading or may be offensive to good taste or decency.
- ▶ No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after the plate has been ordered or if the application is unclear or incorrectly completed.
- ▶ Plates will be mailed 3–4 weeks after you receive the new certificate of registration.

How to apply

1. To order non-personalized U.S. Veteran Motorcycle plates, mark first option and go to step 7.
2. To order personalized U.S. Veteran
3. Motorcycle plates, mark second option and choose 1–4 characters. If you choose 4 characters, no spaces are allowed.



If you choose 3 or fewer characters, you may request a space between any of the characters. Indicate a space with a diagonal line as shown here.



4. Use capital letters or numbers. The letter O and the number zero are the same. The following are not acceptable: small letters, symbols, signs, hyphens, apostrophes, etc. Carefully distinguish between: letters L or I and number 1, letter S and number 5, letter G and number 6, letter Z and number 2, letter B and number 8, letters U and V.

6. Provide meaning of request, i.e., what does this represent?
7. If the vehicle that you wish to register with U.S. Veteran Motorcycle plates is already titled in your name, send:
 - » Proof of eligibility;
 - » A copy of your Certificate of Registration **or** complete the vehicle description on the application;
 - » A \$15 non-personalized issuance fee or the biennial personalized plate fee (\$30 in even years, \$15 in odd years) plus the \$23 biennial registration fee if the plates expire in the next 3 months.
8. If the vehicle is **not** titled in your name, send:
 - » Proof of eligibility;
 - » A completed title application: [MV1](#) (Private Sale) or [MV11](#) (Dealer Sale);
 - » The title assigned to you;
 - » All required fees, including annual registration fee;
 - » An additional \$15 non-personalized issuance fee or the biennial personalized plate fee (\$30 in even years, \$15 in odd years).
