- **Go Slow In Ice and Snow**

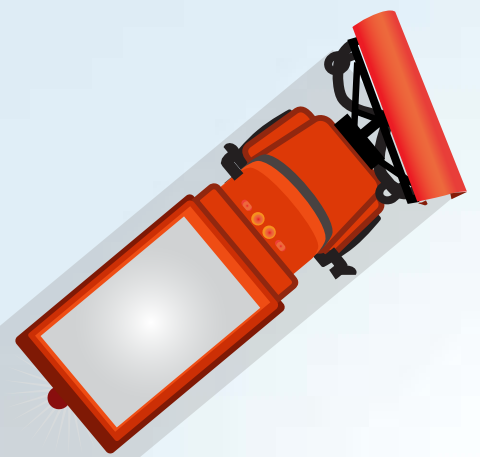
- Drive for conditions

- **Stay Focused**

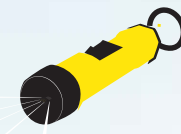
- Buckle Up, Phone Down

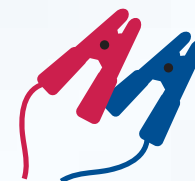

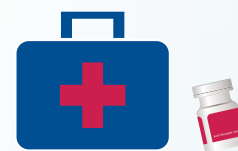
