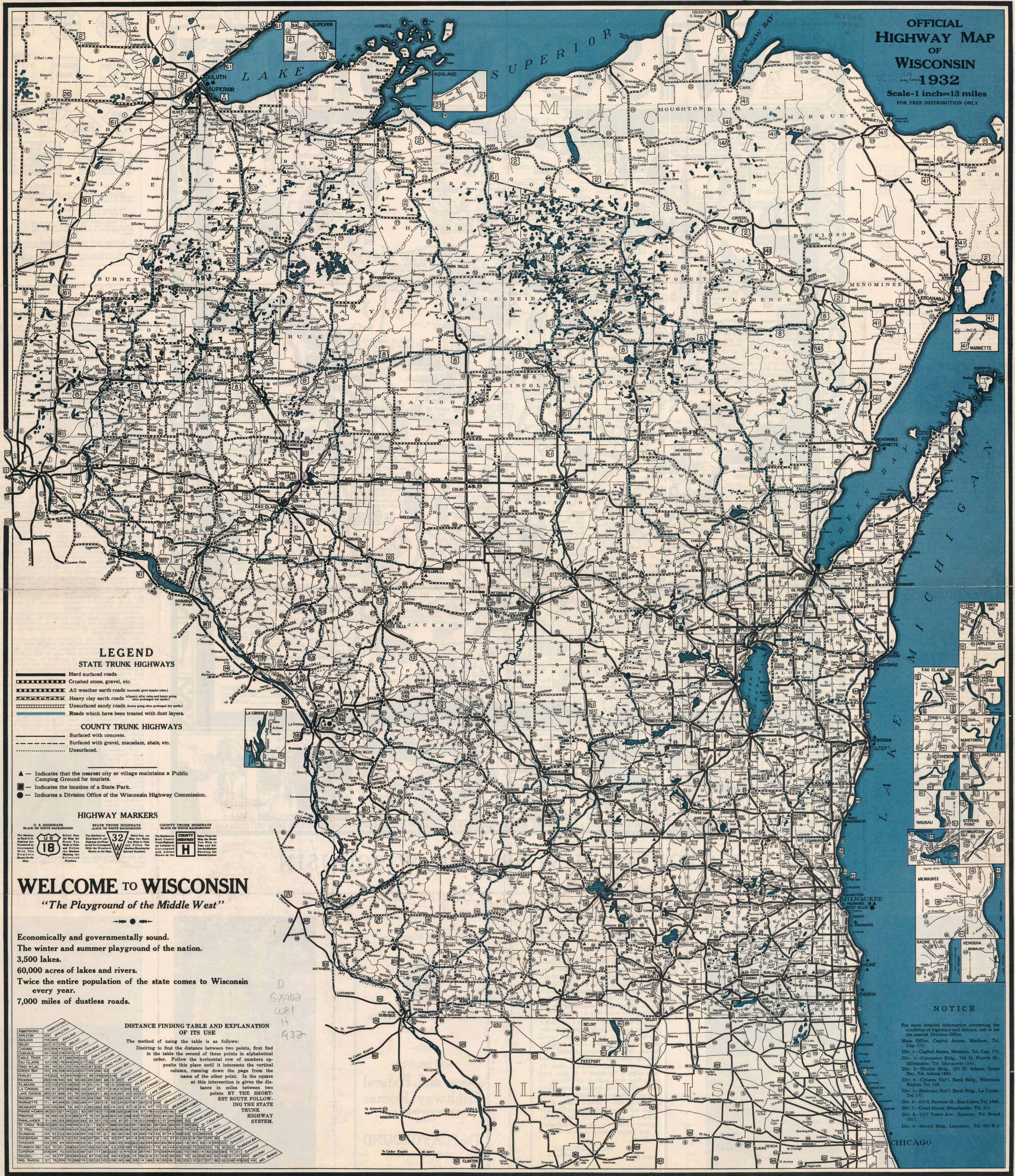


OFFICIAL

- STATE TRUNK HIGHWAYS
Hard surfaced roads.
Crushed stone, gravel, etc.
All weather earth roads (normally good drainage roads).
Heavy clay earth roads (heavy going after prolonged dry spells).
Unsurfaced sandy roads (heavy going after prolonged dry spells).
Roads which have been treated with dust layers.
- COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAYS
Surfaced with concrete.
Surfaced with gravel, macadam, shales, etc.
Unsurfaced.
- ▲ Indicates that the nearest city or village maintains a Public Camping Ground for tourists.
■ Indicates the location of a State Park.

DISTANCE FINDING TABLE AND EXPLANATION OF ITS USE
The method of using the table is as follows:
Desiring to find the distance between two points, first find in the table the second of these points in alphabetical order. Follow the horizontal row of numbers opposite this place until it intersects the vertical column, running down the page from the name of the first point. In the square at this intersection is given the distance in miles between two points BY THE SHORTEST ROUTE FOLLOWING THE STATE TRUNK HIGHWAY SYSTEM.
