

Legend and information section. Includes 'Principal Routes' (Interstate, Expressway, Multilane Divided, 2 Lane Paved), 'Other Routes' (Multilane Divided, 2 Lane Paved, County Highway, Railroad, State Trail), 'Markers' (Interstate, U.S. Highway, State Highway, County Highway, Great River Road, etc.), 'Access and Mileage' (Scale 1 inch = approximately 10 miles), and 'Map & Publication Sales'.

Geographical and administrative information. Includes 'WELCOME TO WISCONSIN 2019-2020', 'Scale 1 inch = approximately 10 miles', 'County names', and 'Points of Interest' (Emergency Hospital, Airport, Fish Hatchery, etc.).

City and village population data. 'Cities and Villages' section with population ranges: Unincorporated (under 2,500), 2,500-4,999, 5,000-9,999, 10,000-29,999, 30,000-99,999, Over 100,000. County seats and state capital are also marked.

Memorial Bridges and Memorial Highways. Lists various bridges and highways with their locations and names.

Wisconsin State Patrol Non-Emergency Assistance. Lists regional offices: North Central Region (757) 845-7143, Northwest Region (757) 839-3000, Southwest Region (920) 846-8500, and Southeast Region (262) 755-4700.

County Location Index. A grid listing all 9 Wisconsin counties with their respective county seat and population.

Wisconsin Historic Sites and Wisconsin Veterans Sites. Lists various historical landmarks and veterans' memorials across the state.

Wisconsin State Patrol Non-Emergency Assistance (continued). Lists regional offices: Northeast Region (920) 929-3700, and Southeast Region (262) 755-4700.

Index to Cities and Villages. A large alphabetical table listing cities and villages in Wisconsin, including their county, population, and area in square miles.

ACCESSIBLE SELFIE STANDS

Selfie stands accessible to all visitors are available in select parks and are located next to a path.

WILLOW RIVER STATE PARK

Snag your selfie using the stand found on the bridge overlooking Willow Falls – it's a short hike &, and worth every step.

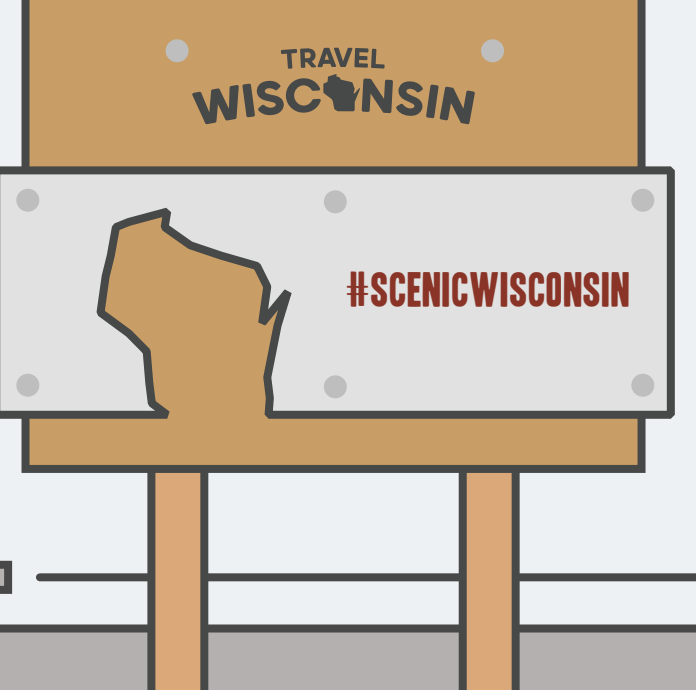
BRUNET ISLAND STATE PARK

Brunet Island's quiet lagoons and channels are particularly great for canoeing and wildlife watching, and its hiking trails mark an intersection with Wisconsin's famed Ice Age National Scenic Trail.

ROCHE-A-CRI STATE PARK

Find Native American petroglyphs carved into the sides of a 300-foot rock outcropping at the heart of the park. Climb the stairway to the top for a panoramic view of the prairie.

AMNICON FALLS STATE PARK

Set your sights on the series of striking waterfalls and rapids that give Amnicon Falls its name. Spot them from trails along the river, or from above on the covered foot bridge.

PENINSULA STATE PARK

Peninsula State Park is an outdoor lover's playground, complete with sandy beaches, summer theatre, hundreds of campsites and a historic lighthouse along eight miles of pristine Door County shoreline.

WHITEFISH DUNES STATE PARK

Wisconsin's highest sand dunes make for an especially scenic selfie backdrop – not just of you, but your dog, too! A marked dog beach nearby provides ample space for pups to play.

KOHLER-ANDRAE STATE PARK

Roll on a mile of sandy ocean-like beach along the Lake Michigan shoreline. Adaptive equipment like beach wheelchairs and special trails ensure everyone can enjoy the water.

HARTMAN CREEK STATE PARK

Cast a line of the accessible fishing pier located on Allen Lake, then show off your catch using the selfie stand at the Allen Lake Picnic Area.

KETTLE MORAIN STATE FORT

Visit the Kettle Moraine Lapham Peak Unit for a breathtaking, bird's-eye view from atop the observation tower. It's the highest point in Waubesa County, and a perfect place to spot fall color.

DEVIL'S LAKE STATE PARK

You can thank a glacier for leaving behind the legendary rock formations and quartzite bluffs of Devil's Lake, making this park one of Wisconsin's most popular and scenic destinations.

BIG FOOT BEACH STATE PARK

Just minutes from downtown Lake Geneva, enjoy a swimming beach, popular picnic area and miles of hiking trails on the shore of beautiful Geneva Lake.
