

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this outreach is to gather input regarding the proposed improvements and traffic management strategies during construction. The improvement project is currently scheduled to begin in the spring of 2026 and is expected to be completed by the fall of 2026.

### **Project Information**

We are proposing to improve 13.6 miles of WIS 107.



The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the function, operation, and safety of WIS 107 between Wilderness Drive and County S in Lincoln County.

The project is needed to address the deteriorating pavement conditions and drainage facilities along WIS 107. The existing asphalt surface in this section of WIS 107 is exhibiting signs of deterioration in the form of alligator cracking, longitudinal cracking, transverse cracking, patching, and rutting. Several culverts along the corridor are showing signs of corrosion, damage, and silting which could potentially lead to failure.

Proposed Improvements include:


- Milling one inch from existing pavement and overlaying with two inches of new asphalt
- Full depth patching of asphalt in certain areas
- Replacing deteriorated culverts
- Improving the railroad crossing with new surface and warning systems
- Remarking pavement markings

Environmental studies and historical/archaeological surveys are underway.

# **Proposed traffic impacts**

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in the spring of 2026.

During construction, the roadway will remain open to traffic using flagging operations. There will be a detour required for the railroad crossing resurfacing work that is anticipated to last one week.



Construction is currently scheduled for completion in the fall of 2026.

#### Real estate

No right of way or real estate impacts are anticipated at this time.
