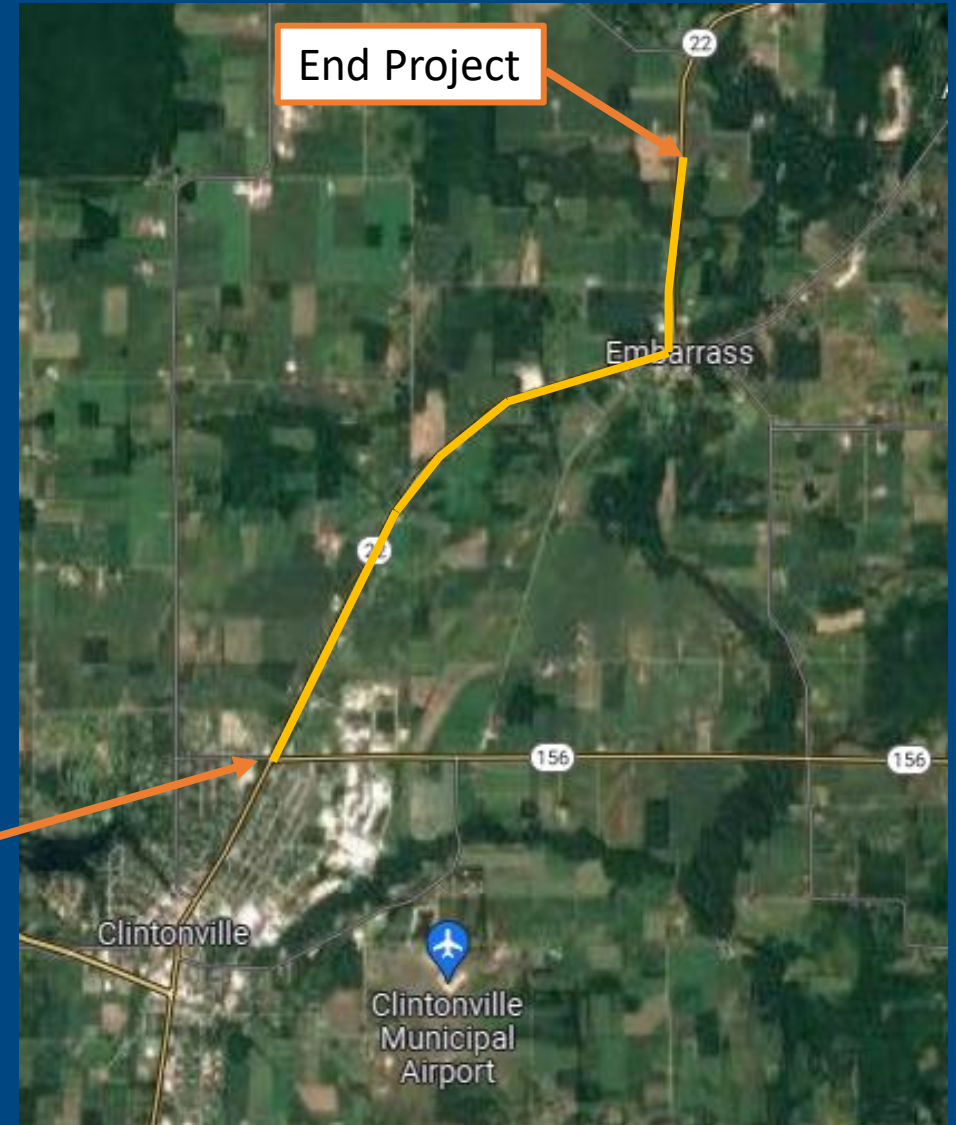
Purpose of Public Involvement

- Our objective during this meeting is to discuss the project status and obtain your input on the following to improve WIS 22
 - Identified needs
 - Proposed improvements
 - Traffic management



Project Location

- WIS 22, Waupaca and Shawano County
 - WIS 156 to Lake Wagner Road



Project purpose and need

Deteriorating Pavement

- Pavement is approaching the end of its service life
- Showing signs of distress with extensive longitudinal and transverse cracking
- These cracks allow water and deicing chemicals to enter the pavement and accelerate the deterioration of the roadway corridor



Project purpose and need

Americans with Disabilities (ADA) curb ramps

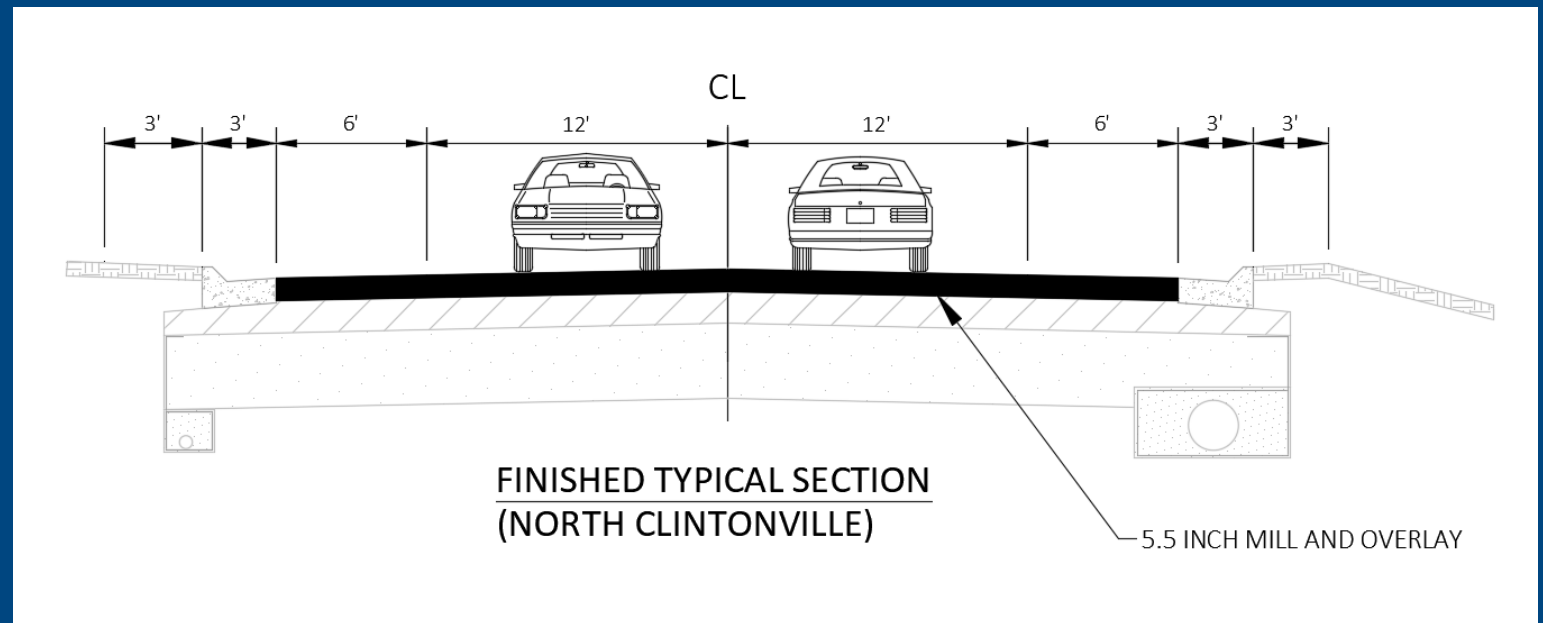
- All curb ramps in the village of Embarrass will be updated to meet ADA requirements as feasible.
- Minor real estate impacts required for grading around each ramp.



Proposed Improvements

Clintonville

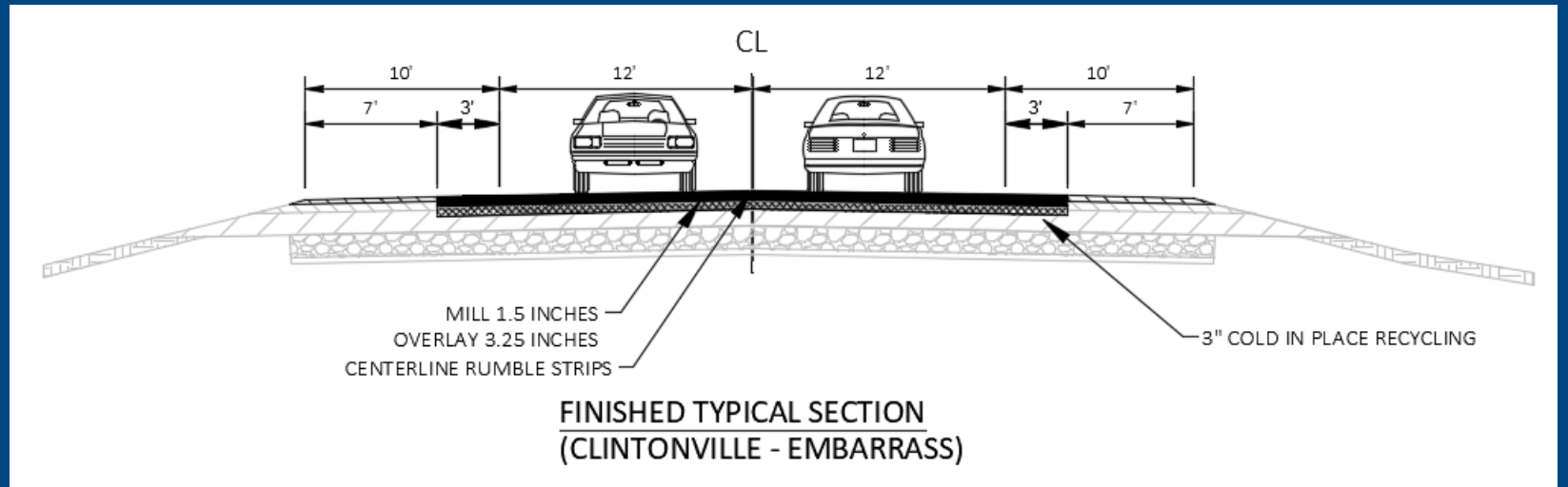
- Remove 5.5 inches of existing pavement
- Replace with 5.5 inches of new asphaltic pavement



Proposed Improvements

Rural areas

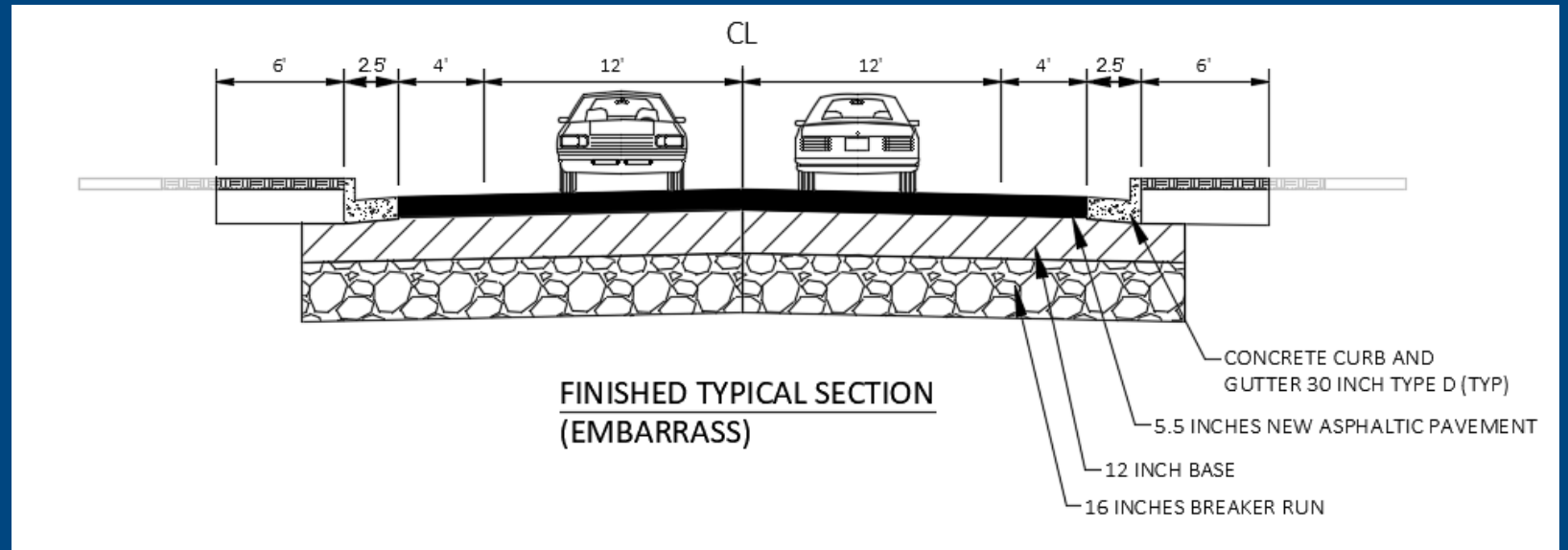
- Remove 1.5 inches of existing pavement
- 3 inch cold-in-place recycle
- Overlay with 2.25 inches of new asphaltic pavement



Proposed Improvements

Urban (Embarrass)

- Roadway reconstruction (narrower cross section)
- New concrete curb and gutter
- ADA curb ramp improvements
- Potential utility replacements (sanitary sewer & water)



Real Estate Impacts

- Permanent acquisition (fee title) may be required for minor curb ramp expansions
- Temporary easements may be required for grading at curb ramps
- WisDOT will be coordinating with property owners for any permanent or temporary real estate needs



What will happen to traffic?

- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained
- Work will be done under traffic using lane closures and flagging operations for the work in Clintonville and for rural portions of the project
- A detour will be utilized during the work through Embarrass.
- The detour route is yet to be determined.
