Purpose

Wisconsin (WIS) 44 project length is approximately 0.02 miles centered on the existing structure B-24-0019. WIS 44 over B-24-0019 in the Village of Kingston serves as a major collector highway. This segment of WIS 44 is a two-lane rural highway with one 12-foot lane in each direction. In the areas adjacent to the bridge, the shoulders are 6 feet wide, of which 4 feet is paved. There is guardrail at the edge of both paved shoulders.

The existing structure (B-24-0019) is located on WIS 44 over the Grand River and the Kingston Dam spillway, in the village of Kingston. B-24-0019 is a two span, haunched slab bridge supported by concrete abutments on piling. The abutments are built behind the existing dam spillway walls. The deck is 78-feet long and 34-feet wide and has a steel tubular railing.

The purpose of the proposed action is to preserve the roadway asset and minimize the overall life cycle cost of the corridor. This can be accomplished by addressing the following needs:

Bridge deficiencies


A meeting was previously held with local officials and their feedback is under consideration by the project team.

Project Information

WisDOT is proposing to improve Bridge B-24-0019. Proposed improvements include milling and removing the top of the existing destressed concrete bridge deck, performing spot repairs, and adding a new concrete overlay. Other project work includes surface repairs to isolated areas of the spillway walls under the bridge and installing short sections of new asphalt bridge approaches.

The environmental study, archaeological, and historical studies have begun and are anticipated to be completed in summer 2023.

Proposed traffic impacts

During construction, the roadway over B-24-0019 will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction. Motorists can expect to encounter single lane closures utilizing temporary traffic signals. Access across the bridge and to/from the adjacent intersection with County B will be maintained at all times.
