## **Proposed Improvements**

#### **County K intersection:**

• Proposed roundabout to improve vehicular safety.

#### South of County K to the northern Village of Walworth limits:

- 4.5-inch mill and overlay resurface to improve pavement conditions.
- Grading and drainage improvements (ditching and culvert pipes) are anticipated at multiple locations.
- Trimming of vegetation will occur at the Six Corners Road and Brick Church Road intersection to improve sight distance.
- Proposed raised, mountable islands to be installed on Six Corners Road and Brick Church Road to control turning movements and slow traffic.
- Possible US 14 speed limit reduction to 45 mph through the Six Corners Road and Brick Church Road intersection for safety improvements.

#### Northern Village of Walworth limits to Knoll Road:

- Urban pavement replacement with new curb and gutter within the Village of Walworth.
- Storm sewer evaluation.
- On-street bicycle accommodations.
- Existing sidewalk to remain in place, with the replacement of curb ramps at all side road intersections to ensure ADA compliance.

#### Knoll Road to the Illinois State Line:

- Rural pavement replacement and new ditching.
- New paved and gravel shoulders.

#### WIS 67/Lakeville Road intersection:

· Potential roundabout to improve vehicular safety.

#### Village Square and Heyer Park:

- Urban pavement replacement with new curb and gutter. Extensions (bump-outs) where feasible at pedestrian crossings.
- Replacement of the majority of existing sidewalk.
- New traffic signal at Kenosha Street corner with pedestrian scramble phase.
