WIS 59 (Greenfield Avenue) between I-894 and 124th Street is one of the most traveled roadways in Milwaukee County. The planning process is about to begin **FOR RESURFACING AND ADDITIONAL SAFETY RELATED IMPROVEMENTS** to this vital roadway. Starting in May of 2009, and continuing for approximately 3 years, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will conduct planning and engineering work for the needed improvements. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) invites you to the first of a series of Public Information Meetings for the new WIS 59 Greenfield Avenue resurfacing and safety improvement project on May 13, 2009.

This meeting will be an informal, open house format, with representatives from WisDOT available to discuss the proposed project and address questions and concerns. Learn about the factors being considered including the roadway pavement condition, intersection geometrics, access and median modifications, parking, pedestrian, bicycle, and transit accommodations, traffic signal modifications, traffic and crash data. Construction for this segment is currently scheduled for 2012.

This project's success will greatly depend on active participation and input from stake-holders. Early identification of any possible issues or concerns from property owners, residents, service providers and business owners long WIS 59 is crucial to collaboratively working with the community to explore any appropriate solutions.
