Alternative	Reasons for Eliminating	Village/Brown Co./Public Input
2 and 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not address existing bridge grade (4.9 vs. 5.2%)</li> <li>Would maintain the same horizontal &amp; vertical geometry east of the river</li> <li>Alt. 2 would displace 11 businesses &amp; 5 residences</li> <li>Alt. 3 would displace 9 businesses &amp; 3 residences</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Opposed by the Village Board, Brown County, and the Wrightstown Area Business Alliance</li> <li>One person supported Alternative 2, two people were against both Alternatives 2 and 3</li> </ul>
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Would displace 8 businesses on the north side of High Street and 5 residences</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Opposed by the Village Board, Brown County, and the Wrightstown Area Business Alliance. Five public comments received, all opposed</li> </ul>
5 At Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Would raise elevation of Washington St. 5.5 feet, but does not address existing bridge grade (4.2 vs. 5.2%)</li> <li>Would displace 3 businesses and 9 residences</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Opposed by the Village Board and Brown County</li> </ul>
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Would move the Village's busiest intersection in front of St. Clare's School and St. Paul's Parish</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Opposed by the Village Board, Brown County, St. Clare's School, St. Paul's Parish, and 16 people at PIM No.3</li> </ul>
