## Which state issued the most recent title?

Because vehicles can be titled in different states, it is important to review messages generated in PARTNER during processing and/or vehicle inquiry.

**Example:** A title transfer from an out-of-state title, when a Wisconsin title record exists in the DOT database.

I108: This vehicle exists in the WI
Database. The current Out-of-State
title must contain an issue date later
than the WI title date. If not, Mail the
application to DOT.

Last Wisconsin Title Date: Jan 23, 2019

**Example:** A title transfer from a Wisconsin title, when an out-of-state title record exists in NMVTIS.

information System (NMVTIS)
indicates vehicle is already titled in the following state. Ensure the
Wisconsin title contains an issue date later than the out-of-state title: NM

Be aware of these messages and verify the title being used is the most current state of title before continuing with the transaction.

The document upload feature in both eMV PARTNER and some title vendor systems is now available. The supporting document upload feature streamlines your operations and allows you to electronically submit the transaction's documentation after completing processing. This feature is beneficial to your organization as it will reduce:

- Postage costs
- Probability of documents being lost in the mail
- Probability of documents resulting in missing work
