
## EV Hybrid (EVH) Sticker reminder

DMV now requires all APPS agents that process transactions electronically through a vendor system to begin issuing EV / Hybrid (EVH) stickers with license plates issued to electric or hybrid vehicles. A processing modal will prompt agents when to begin issuing the EVH stickers to customers.

DMV began mailing EVH sticker inventory to qualifying organizations at the beginning of April in anticipation of the June 27<sup>th</sup> go live date.

EVH sticker inventory ordering is now available to qualifying organizations.

## Sticker Placement



For standard-sized license plates (e.g. auto, light truck, etc.): place a sticker on the upper-right corner of <u>each</u> plate, to the right of the bolt holes.

For cycles, mopeds and similar non-standard sized plates: place a sicker in the upper-right corner, just to the left of the bolt holes.
