



# CM PERMIT CONDITION SHEET

## SEALED LOAD IN INTERNATIONAL TRADE @ 90,000 lbs.

### 1. AUTHORITY & ELIGIBILITY

- Under Wis. Stats. [s. 348.27\(17\)\(b\)](#) the department may issue annual or consecutive month permits for the **transportation of a sealed load** in vehicles or vehicle combinations that have 6 or more axles and that exceeds the maximum gross weight limitations under Wis. Stats. [s. 348.15\(3\)\(c\)](#) if the vehicle or vehicle combination does not exceed the maximum gross weight limitations under Wis. Stats. [s. 348.29](#).
- "Sealed load" means a load consisting of a container or vehicle, being transported in international trade, that has been sealed with a tamper-evident seal affixed at the time of initial loading.
- Notwithstanding Wis. Stats. [s. 348.15\(8\)](#), any axle of a vehicle or vehicle combination that does not impose on the highway at least 8 percent of the gross weight of the vehicle or vehicle combination may not be counted as an axle for the purposes of Wis. Stats. [s. 348.15\(3\)\(c\)](#).
- This permit does not authorize the operation of any vehicle or vehicle combination at a maximum gross weight in excess of 90,000 pounds.

### 2. SIZE LIMITATIONS – VEHICLE & LOAD

### 3. WEIGHT LIMITATIONS

- Vehicle or vehicle combination cannot exceed the maximum gross weight limitations under Wis. Stats. [s. 348.15\(3\)](#) and [s. 348.29](#).
- Maximum weight cannot exceed **90,000 pounds**.
- Vehicle or vehicle combination must have between 6 and 8 axles.

### 4. ROUTE LIMITATIONS

- Only WisDOT may issue this permit, regardless of the classes of roadway on the route.
- This permit is valid on all interstate highways.

## 5. GENERAL OPERATING REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicles may be operated at the posted speed limit.
- Vehicles that are only overweight may operate 24 hours a day, including weekends and holidays.
- Permits are **not** suspended during the annual spring thaw period.

## 6. MINIMUM INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Bodily injury, each person \$150,000 or \$750,000 combined single limit
- Bodily injury, each accident \$450,000
- Property damage, each accident \$300,000

## 7. VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicle or vehicles must be registered for not less than the maximum registration weight available or the permit weight, whichever is less as required by Wis. Admin. Code ch. [Trans 255.07](#).

## 8. PERMIT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Apply online ONLY at <https://wi.gotpermits.com> or via the [OSOW Website](#).
- Permits may be issued for 3 to 12 months.

## 9. PERMIT FEE INFORMATION

Fees are calculated from the effective **day** of the permit, not the calendar months.

(*Example: 9/5 to 11/20 – greater than 2 months to the day, but less than 3 months, would be calculated as 3 months.*)
