The 2020 Construction season is fast approaching. All trucking firms are required to submit a schedule of owned and/or leased trucks to WisDOT to be considered for work on all highway construction contracts.

Review and submit your firm's annual schedule of owned and/or leased trucks before the extended date of **Thursday April 30, 2020**.

What will the Trucking Schedule accomplish?

- The Trucking Schedule will address <u>ACCOUNTABILITY</u> by providing a better understanding of the responsibility and/or relationship between Brokers, Owner -Operators, Multiple Truck Owners, and Employees.
- It will address the issue of <u>Transparency</u> by providing an overall picture of <u>Trucking</u> in Wisconsin.
- Act as a <u>COMMUNICATION</u> tool between WisDOT and trucking firms to better address compliance issues in meeting both Federal and State requirements on WisDOT Projects through monitoring
 - * The relationship of trucking utilization as applied to project schedules
 - FHWA 1273 distribution to ALL contracting and trucking tiers as required
 - * Addresses DBE Program requirements and the DBE replacement policy
