2020 schedule of owned/leased trucking submittals

The 2020 construction season is fast approaching. All trucking firms are required to submit a schedule of owned and/or leased trucks to WisDOT to be considered for work on all highway construction contracts. Review and submit your firm's annual schedule of owned and/or leased trucks before the extension date of

What is a dedicated source?

- A borrow pit, stockpile site, concrete or asphalt batch plant source etc. established specifically for the performance of the contract or project.
- Has NOT been open and making sales of that material to the general public within the previous 12 months of the day the project was let to contract (bid opening—not awarded).
- AND adjacent or virtually adjacent to the site of the work.
- Generally, WisDOT will consider virtually adjacent if the boundary of the material source is located a half mile or less (as the crow flies) of the closest right of way boundary or termini to the project.
