- 2. MOTP A. Albers (10 mins)
 - Changes due: August 1
 - Tech team was provided a reminder of where the current and archived documents are stored.
- 3. Task Force Updates T. Mandal/ J. Bruesewitz (10 mins)
 - ASR Testing

- ASR testing is complete on 46 quarries. A few tests have failed and BTS will verify these failures. Once the testing is complete the task force will resume to consider the results.
- Instead of identifying testing based on geologic properties, we will specify which counties will require ASR testing as part of source approval.
- The task force will determine testing frequency and how this will fold into the source approval program.
- MSE Wall Backfill
 - Study is expected to finish in 2025. The complete report will be discussed with the task force and aggregate technical team.
- 4. Spec Changes T. Mandal (20 min)
 - There will not be a standard specification book published in 2026, all specification changes will be made through an ASP-6.
 - SS 310: Aggregate Gradation
 - SS 701: Material Placement Notification (MPN)
 - Internal discussion has decided that WisDOT will no longer require the MPN for aggregates at this time. This specification will be included for concrete operations only.
 - SS 730: Small Quantity QC Testing
 - Specific small quantity overrun testing to cover scenarios where the overrun is significantly more than a lot. Suggestion to specify testing for each 3000 tons, similar to point 3 in paragraph 2 of 730.3.4.1.
 - CMM 834: Aggregate Sampling
- 5. Subcommittee Priorities T. Mandal (20 min)
 - Update/Redefine Material Categories
 - Recycled Concrete F/T
 - Consider using the IA program to assess tester and procedure differences.
 - Consider sample size as an attempt to reduce variability.
 - Placing Virgin Aggregate on Top of RAP
 - The committee will form a taskforce of subject matter experts including construction experts so this issue can be assessed from diverse angles.
 - Backfill Spec Revisions
- 6. State-wide F/T testing All (10 min)
 - WisDOT recently presented the state-wide F/T policy change to the APW board.
 - Aggregate suppliers and labs will be notified through a memo, so they have enough notice to prepare. Likely will take place in 2027.
 - A memo will be drafted through the subcommittee meeting.

- MTE and Yahara have recent experiences purchasing Thermotron chambers. Lead time can be over a year for delivery.
