- Updated MOTP was published in December for January 2025 lets.
- Updates related to concrete procedures include: T22, T24, T97, T152, T309, WTP-C001.
- Deadline for submitting requests for future updates will be August 1.
- 4. WHRP Research Updates T. Mandal/ A. Graff (20 min)
 - Chemistry and Performance of SCMs for Wisconsin Concrete Pavement
 - o Completed, and final report should be out by the end of February.
 - Alternative Conditioning Method to Calculate Formation Factor for Wisconsin Concrete Pavement
 - Still ongoing. Researchers found some discrepancies in the data that may require further testing, such as petrography.
 - Proactive Prevention of Pavement Buckling
 - Still Ongoing. Researchers are running simulations. These researchers are the same as the optimization of dowel bars research team.
 - Optimization of Dowel Bars in Concrete Pavements
 - Initial meeting with researchers was held to discuss the work plan and will meet again this spring.

 - First class being held at the end of January. WisDOT will use an ASP-6 to modify spec language about the new certification.
