

- 76 Federally recognized Tribes consulted, 13 indicated they would sign, six signatures received thus far: Stockbridge-Munsee Community of WI, Winnebago Tribe of NE, Sokaogon Chippewa Community, Peoria Tribe of Indians of OK, Miami Tribe of OK, and Match-e-be-nash-she-wish Band of Pottawatomis Indians.

U.S. Highway (USH) 10, Wood, Portage, and Waupaca Counties [47PT159 (Burley Brew), 47PT160 (Dambroski), and 47PT191 (Blinded by the Light)]

MOA executed in 1998. No sunset date.

- Stipulation III – Interpretive display – content for the interpretive display has been finalized, stipulation is underway.

Panels are complete and MAP is actively working on contracting production and installation; installation is anticipated by July 2026. The Request for Bid is complete and Notice of Intent to Award will be sent in January 2026 with a contract in place February 2026.

When contract is finalized, detail on fabrication time will be provided and the schedule and installation coordination can begin. Anticipated completion of this stipulation is within state fiscal year 2026 or no later than June 30, 2026. A more precise timeline can be provided when the awarded contract is finalized.

US 41/WIS 29, Brown County [Pamperin Park North (47BR389) and monitor]

MOA executed December 2009 and amended in November 2010. Sunset date two years from construction.

MOA includes WisDOT ID# 1133-03-02, WHS# 01-1584/BR. Phase 3 data recovery of 47BR389 (Pamperin Park North) site is complete. MAP archaeologists met with the Oneida Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) for a discussion of culturally sensitive issues regarding field procedures and discoveries. Oneida THPO was notified daily of work location and progress. Interim reports were provided to WisDOT and the THPOs on a bi-weekly basis.

WHS archaeologists gave a public talk on May 17, 2011, at the former WHS museum summarizing the archaeological work and its results. WisDOT received credit as the project sponsor. The talk was recorded and is publicly accessible at <https://pbswisconsin.org/watch/university-place/university-place-an-ancient-settlement-in-brown-county-ep-589/>.

Coordination with the Oneida and Menomonee THPOs occurred in summer 2025. No response was received from the Menomonee THPO, but the Oneida THPO determined that the publicly available archaeology talk is sufficient public interpretation.

MOA closed out in June 2025.



- Story Hill Residential Historic District 2 and 3 Noise Barrier Design Plan – The majority of receptors voted against the noise barrier; therefore, the barrier will not be constructed. Consulting parties were informed via email in January 2025 and a final plan was not prepared.
- Signage Plan for Northwestern Branch, National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers' National Historic Landmark and Historic District – Final plan sent to consulting parties in February 2025.
- Soldiers' Home National Historic Landmark and National Register Historic District Wall Design Plan – Final plan sent to consulting parties in March 2025.
- Archaeological monitoring report submitted in March 2025 for geotechnical borings. Monitoring for geotechnical borings occurred in November/December 2024; the borings were taken to support the wall design.
- Soldiers' Home National Historic Landmark and National Register Historic District Landscape Plan – Final plan sent to consulting parties in May 2025.
- Soldiers' Home National Historic Landmark and National Register Historic District, Wood National Cemetery Monitoring Plan – Final plan sent to consulting parties in August 2025. The following plan implementation actions have occurred:

Archaeological data recovery has been completed. Reports for the burial issue have been submitted and accepted by WisDOT and WHS. WisDOT and FHWA are working with the Ho Chunk Nation and Dane County Parks to update the MOA to address the outstanding public interpretation stipulation. Dane County Parks has developed a public interpretation plan that will include interpretation of the archaeological research results and are awaiting confirmation of WisDOT financial support to move forward.

MOA will be updated in early 2026 after WisDOT's financial commitment is made to address outstanding public interpretation stipulation.


