General Notes:

The minimum amount of information the Department requires for review is crash test videos, crash test reports, eligibility/approval letters, drawings, installation manuals, and maintenance manuals to determine if a product can be placed on the Approved Product List.

If a manufacturer submits a product without running the full crash test matrix one of the following documents is required:

1. A document from a ISO/IEC 17025 (A2LA) accredited lab that provides a detailed justification for not running the full matrix of tests.
This lab is to be independent of the manufacturer.
2. A P.E. stamped document that provides a detailed justification for not running the full matrix of tests.
P.E. is to be licensed in the State of Wisconsin.

Immediately report any manufacturer's modification to approved product to the Department's contact person listed above.

The Department reserves the right to request additional information at any time.

Providing documentation to the Department does not automatically grant approval of product.

Information provide to the Department is considered Fair Use under the copy right Act of 1979. The Department can use information provided for criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, education, and research. WisDOT is also allowed to use information provided in manuals, other documents, and electronic communications free of charge.

Failure to report changes can cause hardware to be removed from Approved Product List.
