Questions

Please be prepared to answer the following questions in order provided during your interview:

- 1) What is your estimated capacity to deliver over the next two to three years? How will you ensure contract requirements are met on time? What are potential risks to project delivery and what are your strategies to mitigate these delivery risks?
- 2) The USH 53 & USH 14/61 will require complex, multi-modal traffic staging to build. What is your team's experience with downtown, urban design that involves complex staging and multi-modal traffic coordination while maintaining access to all businesses?
- 3) Construction along the USH 53 corridor will include complex pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along with intersection design in close proximity to existing building facades. What is your team's experience designing urban intersections with complex pedestrian and bicycle accommodations that also include signal and lighting design?
- 4) The City of La Crosse is proposing to replace all of their municipal utilities where the pavement is being replaced. What is your team's experience coordinating and designing storm sewer replacements alongside underground water and sanitary sewer replacements while maintaining access to businesses? What strategies or innovations will your team use to evaluate and identify any utility conflicts?
- 5) The nature of the USH 53 corridor includes high profile public and private stakeholders. What is your team's experience, approach, and strategies for coordinating with these entities? What would your team's plan for continuous public outreach with dense residential, commercial, and industrial neighborhoods?
