

Job Aid: Accessing DOT Learn Center


Sponsor's Guide training must be completed by successful applicants to either the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), or the Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ) improvement program. This training must be completed once every three years and encompasses both TAP and CMAQ program guidance.

The Sponsor's Guide to Non-Traditional Transportation Project Implementation (Sponsor's Guide) provides information and instructions to Sponsors to help them successfully develop TAP and CMAQ projects in accordance with Federal and State laws and regulations. The Sponsor must become familiar with the Sponsor's Guide so that they understand the responsibilities they are accepting when applying for the benefit of using Federal Funding.
