DT2188 Form Instructions**



How to complete the DT2188 Form

The DT2188 Form was created for ease of use and consistency across UCP Certifying Agencies. Below are instructions to help you navigate through the form and provide additional resources and information during your selection process.

Contact information for each certifying agency is listed at the bottom of the page if you need further assistance.

The DT2188 Form is a fillable form.

1. This form includes the most common North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Codes encountered in DBE certification but is not an exhaustive list of all NAICS Code Index Entries. All of your firm's NAICS Code Index Entries may not appear on this form. Click on the NAICS Code or Sector Title for additional information and Index Entries not listed found on page 2.
2. Place a check mark next to the work categories, services, supplies, or manufactured materials under the applicable NAICS Code consistent with the work your firm will be engaged in and for which you are seeking DBE Certification.
3. If your firm's work category description(s) is not listed, proceed to page 2 of the form and enter the information manually where indicated.

Completing the form:

1. Place a checkmark next to all applicable geographic area(s) your firm is interested in providing services or products
2. Review each NAICS Code Classification in each section on pages 1 and 2. Place a checkmark in the box next to all applicable work category descriptions under that NAICS Code.
  - a. OTHER - If a work category description is not found under a specific NAICS Code, move to the bottom of page 2 and manually enter the NAICS Code and associated work category description in the space provided highlighted in yellow.

Page 2: Additional information:

1. Click on the NAICS Code webpage link to search for NAICS Codes. Enter a word/phrase or NAICS Code in the search bar at the top of the page – or – click on the "Code" or "Section Title" (upper right-hand box – page 2). This will automatically redirect you to the NAICS Code page or specified Section Title. Drill down to the desired Code/description or to find additional Index Entries and information.
2. At a Glance Reference – this section provides a brief description of the types of work associated with a specific Prefix Code and associated work groups/classifications as defined under the NAICS Code description for each NAICS Code.
