# Project Location

- US 10, Portage County
  - Old Highway 18 Road to County J



# Project purpose and need

## Roadway deficiencies

- Pavement condition
  - Distresses
- Culvert/inlet condition
- Concrete barrier and guardrail condition



# Proposed Improvements

- Concrete pavement repair/replacement
  - US 10, County J and Ramps
- Mill and overlay Two-Way Left Turn Lane (TWLTL)
- Replace existing asphaltic paved shoulders
- Replace curb and gutter in spot locations based on condition
- Repair/Replace existing concrete barrier in median
- Update beam guard on County J

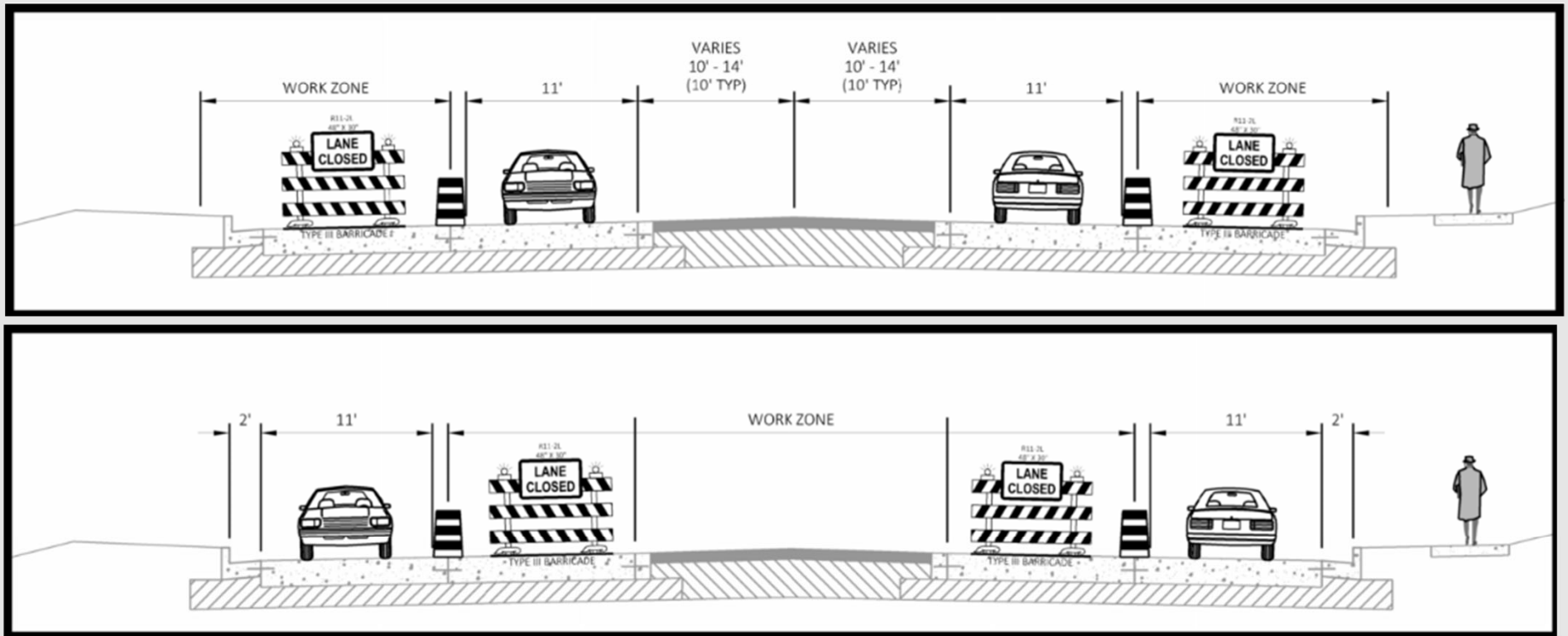


# Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Construction currently anticipated for 2028.
- During construction, motorists can expect single-lane closures or bidirectional traffic.
  - Advanced notification will be given for temporary disruptions to access due construction operations

- Access maintained to businesses during hours of operation
  - Coordination to determine any opportunities for short-term access closures
- Anticipate short term nighttime closures of ramps at County J interchange
