






Project Location/Description







Project Location/Description Cont.

- WIS 13 is a connecting highway
 - Carries state highway traffic on a local street
 - Connecting highway aids from WisDOT help the City maintain WIS 13 to state highway standards
 - Wisconsin Rapids
 - Maintains the roadway and drainage systems
 - Controls access
 - Owns the right of way





Project Purpose

 The primary purpose of this project is to address identified needs within the corridor, preserve the roadway, and minimize the overall life cycle cost.





Project Need

Roadway

- The existing WIS 13 roadway surface is showing signs of deterioration.
- The existing third southbound lane between Ruby and Dove Avenues is functionally unnecessary.
- The pedestrian curb ramps withing the corridor do not meet Americas with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.





Project Need Cont.

- Safety
 - Traffic signal visibility
 - Pedestrian crosswalk visibility





Proposed Improvements

- Replace the existing concrete pavement with new base course and hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement.
- Replace the existing driveway aprons and curb and gutter.
- Replace the traffic signals at the intersections of WIS 13/ County Z (Griffith Avenue) and WIS 13/ Kuhn Avenue. Proposed signals will include a signal head per approaching lane and arrow indicators for turning vehicles.
- Remove the third southbound lane along WIS 13 between Ruby Avenue and Dove Avenue.





Proposed Improvements Cont.

- Replace the existing curb ramps with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant ramps.
- Replace or modify the existing storm sewer network to match the final roadway/curb and gutter elevations.






Proposed Improvements Cont.

- Current considerations being investigated
 - Extend the sidewalk from the existing limits approximately 200-feet South of County Z (Griffith Avenue) on the east side of WIS 13 to Lakewood Lane.
 - Access modifications
 - Intersection geometric modifications
 - Pedestrian crossing locations






Anticipated Traffic Impacts

- WIS 13 will remain open to through traffic, with typically one lane of traffic in each direction.
- Temporary traffic signals are planned for use at the existing signalized intersections.
- Short-term sideroad intersection and driveway closures.
 Consecutive sideroad will not be closed.
- Pedestrian accommodations will be maintained.






Anticipated Traffic Impacts – Stage 1








Anticipated Traffic Impacts – Stage 2

Real Estate

- Additional right of way will be required for this project. The areas where additional right of way will be needed are:
 - Sidewalk additions/replacements
 - Curb ramp replacements
 - Temporary pedestrian accommodations
 - Intersection modifications
- City of Wisconsin Rapids will acquire real estate
 - Preliminary real estate needs shown on the exhibits
