Purpose

The purpose of the WIS 22 public involvement is to:

- Present information regarding the current condition and needs of the structure
- Provide information on the proposed improvements to WIS 22
- Obtain your input and answer your questions

Project Information

We are proposing to improve 0.125 miles of WIS 22. The purpose of the proposed project is to address the deteriorated structure over the unnamed tributary to the Labutzke Channel.

Proposed Improvements Include:

- Replacing the bridge
- · Replacing guardrail to current standards
- Removing the spillway and performing streambed restoration
- Placement of rock weirs within the channel

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is currently scheduled to occur during the 2027 construction season.

During construction WIS 22 will be closed at the bridge. During the road closure, traffic would be detoured along WIS 55, WIS 29 and WIS 117.

Real estate

Additional right of way will be required for this project. Small areas of acquisition will be required in all four quadrants of the structure and along the existing spillway. Preliminary right of way impacts are shown on the exhibits. WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in spring of 2025.
