




# **Needs**

- Structure deterioration
  - Deterioration at piers, girders and deck

























# **Proposed Improvements**

- Replace the existing bridge
- Widen pedestrian sidewalks to six feet
- Replace approach pavement
- Install lighting and pavement markings on new bridge







## **Traffic Control**

- WIS 64 will be closed at the bridge.
  - Through traffic will be detoured via County K, County Q and County Z.
  - A shuttle service will be provided for pedestrians.

















#### Real Estate

- Temporary easements will be needed for construction access.
- Additional permanent right-of-way will be needed for maintenance purposes.
  - The real estate acquisition process is set to begin in April 2025.







#### **Schedule**

- Public input received by Feb. 7, 2025
- Environmental document completed April 2025
- Begin real estate acquisition April 2025
- Finalize design February 2026
- Construction currently scheduled 2028
  - Construction could begin in 2027 if funding becomes available.
