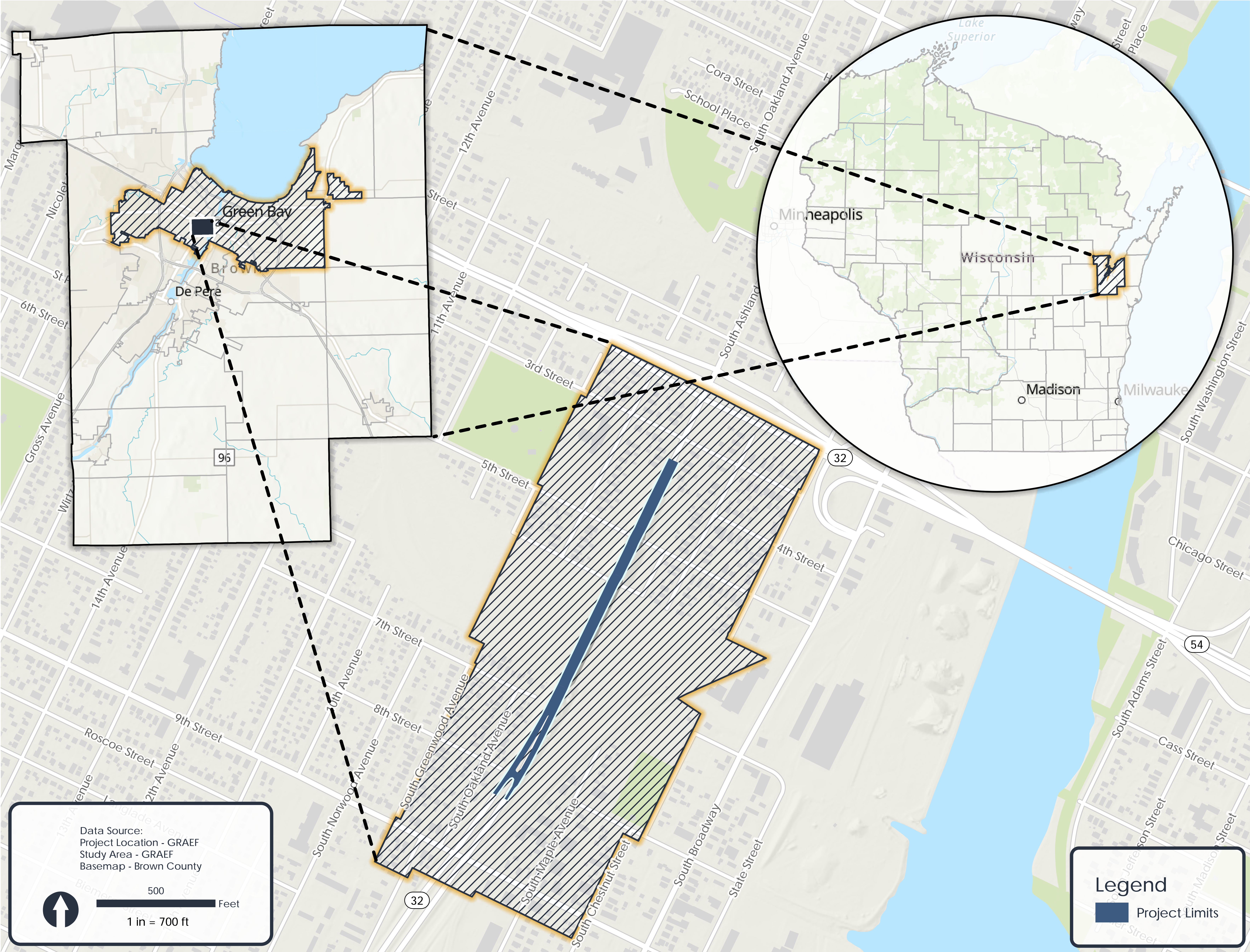
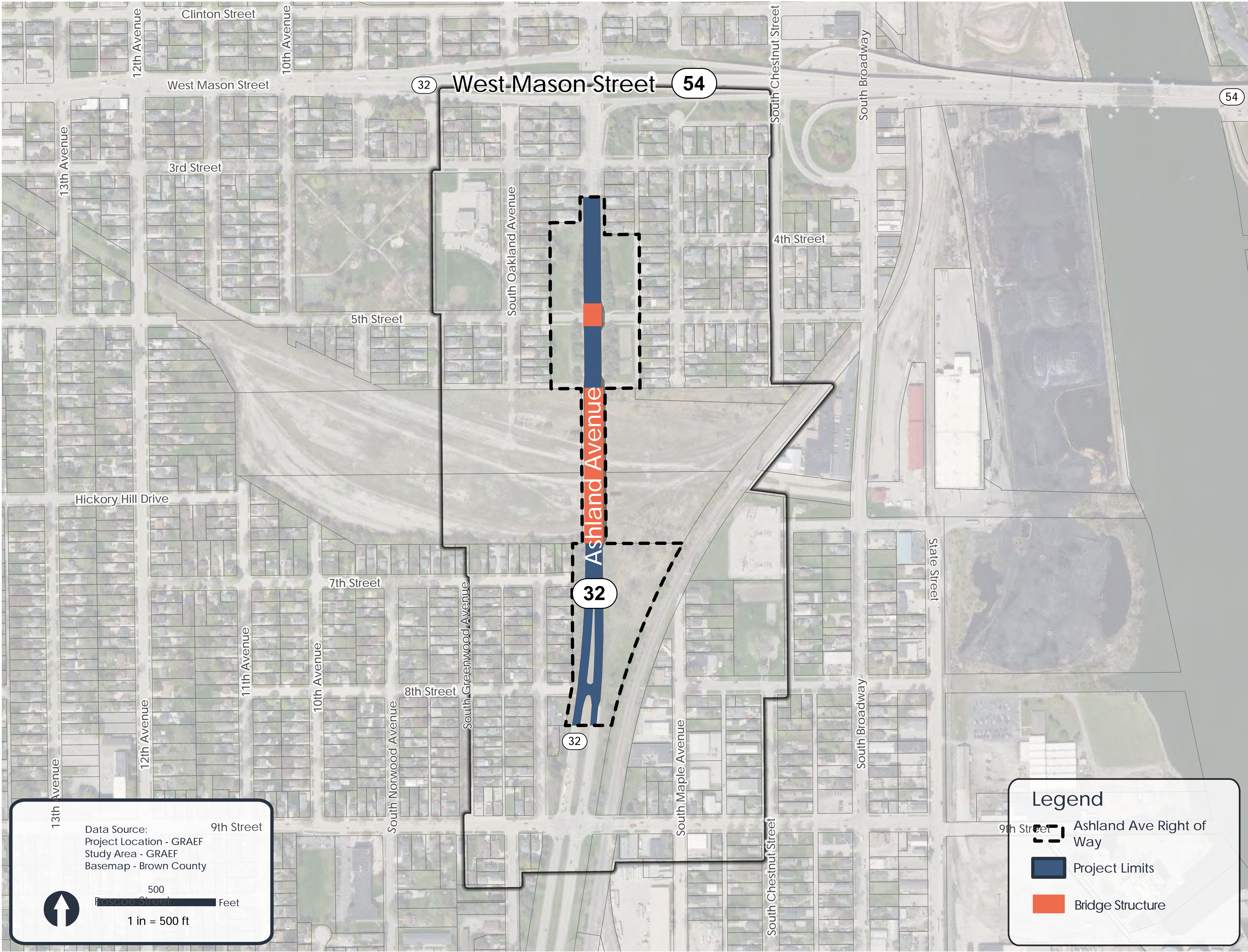

PURPOSE & NEED

The purpose of the project is to address the poor condition of the WIS 32 / Ashland Avenue roadway, the bridge spanning over the former Canadian National Railroad rail yard, and adjacent retaining walls.

The project needs are anticipated to be the following:

- Bridge condition
- Safety conditions
- Bicycle and pedestrian accommodations

Proposed concepts to be studied are:

- No build
- At-grade alternative/bridge removal
- Bridge replacement

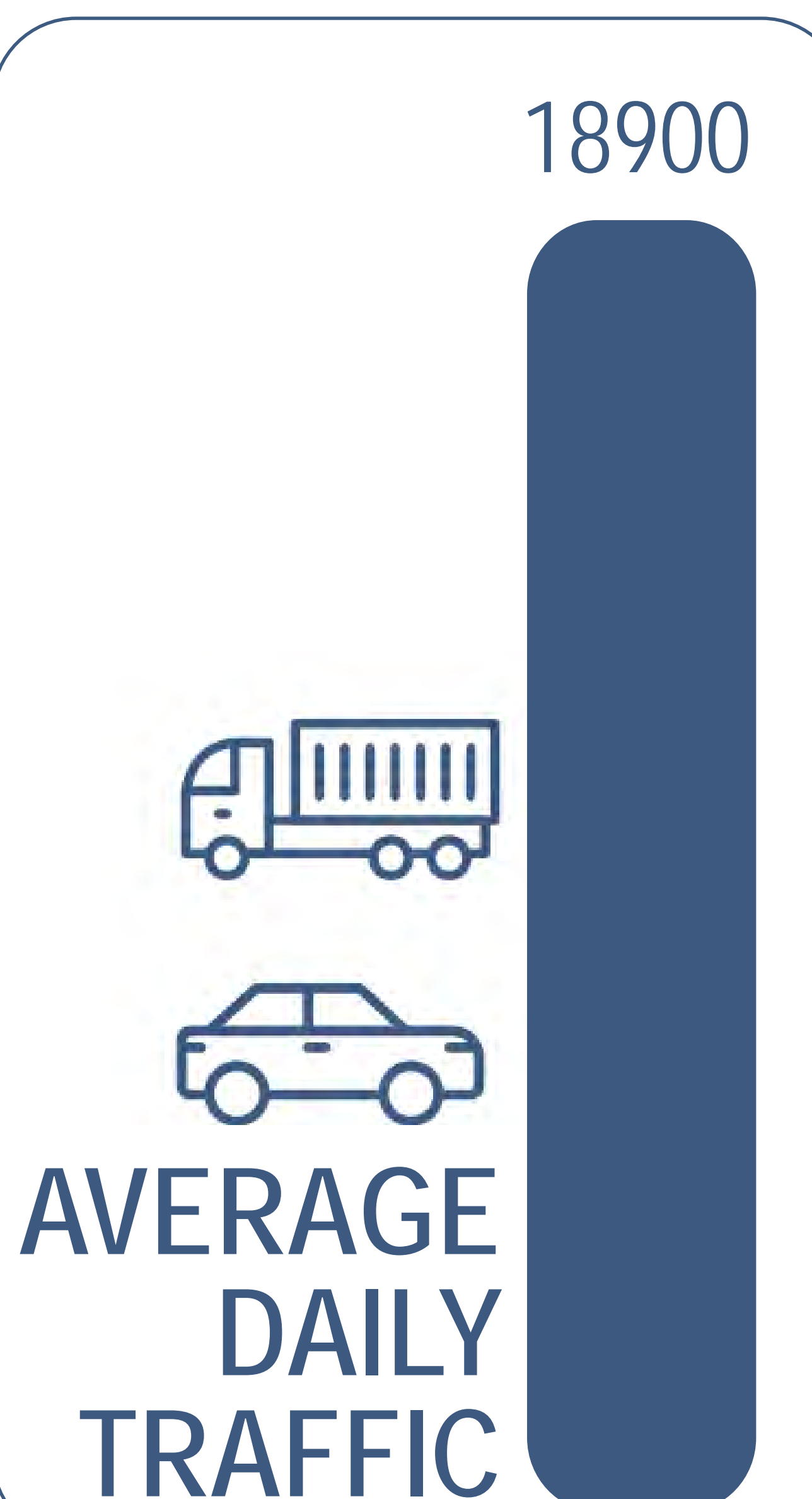
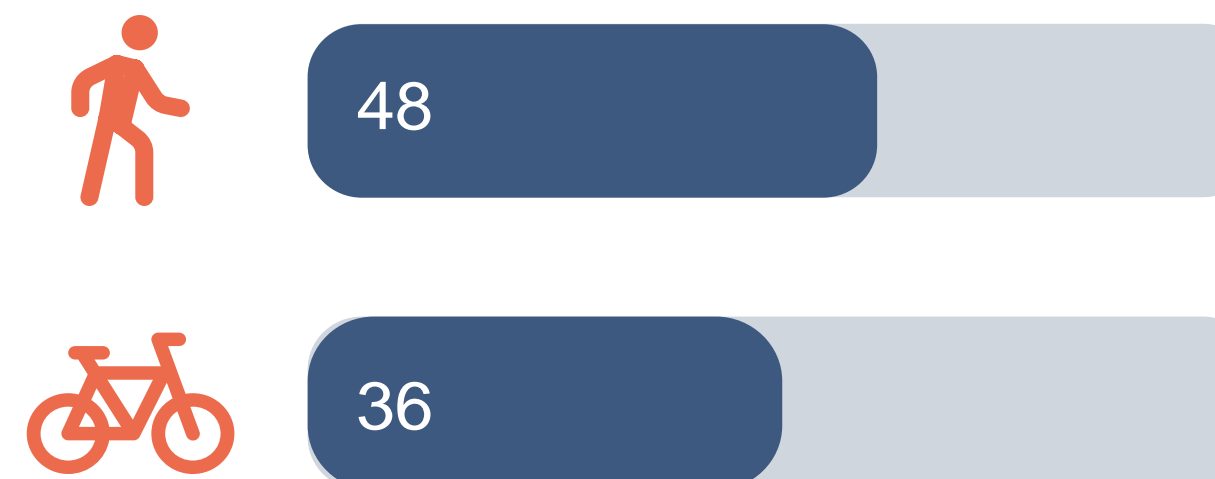
The study phase of the project will complete the required environmental document and identify a preferred alternative that will move forward in design and construction.

Former Canadian National Railroad Rail Yard

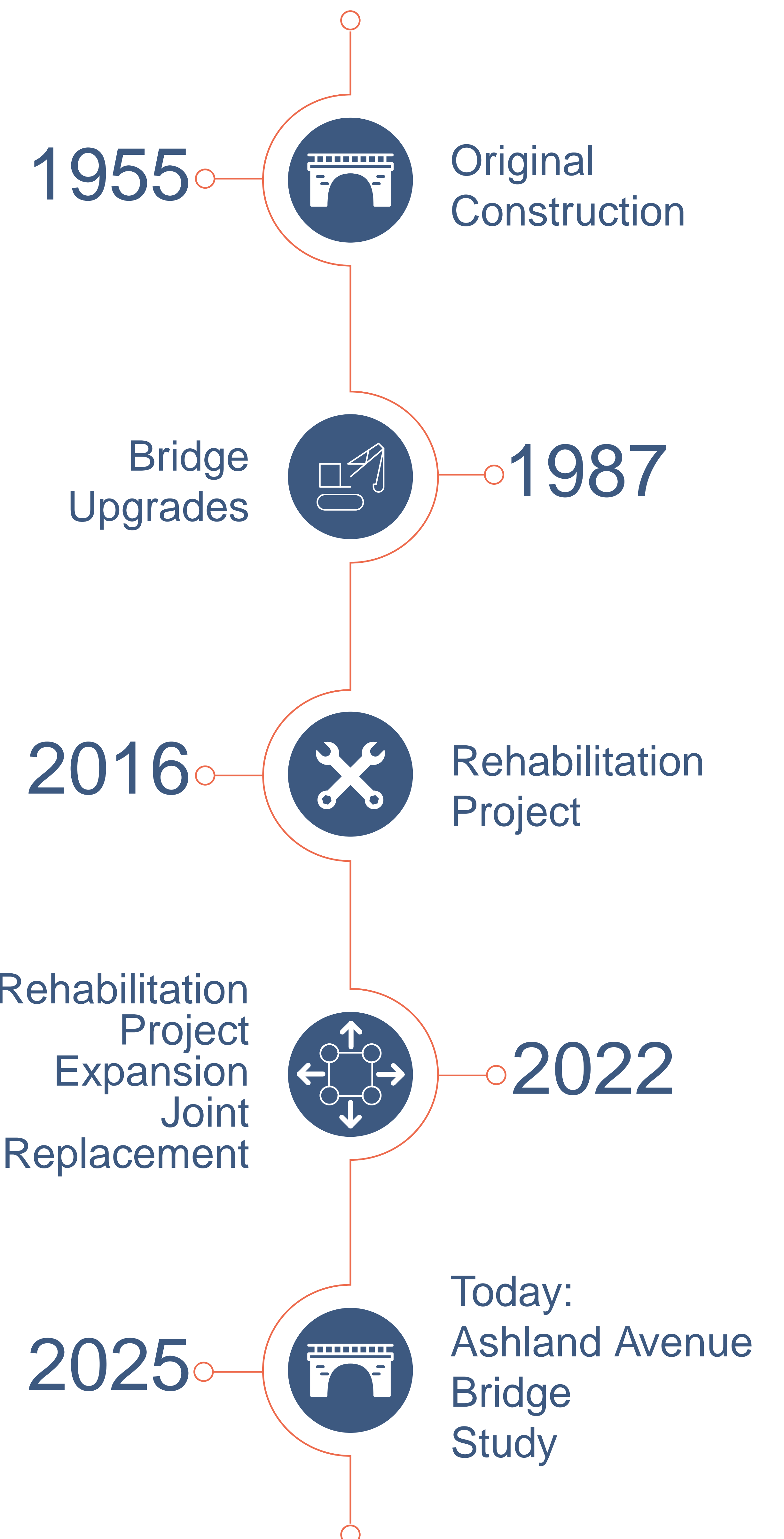

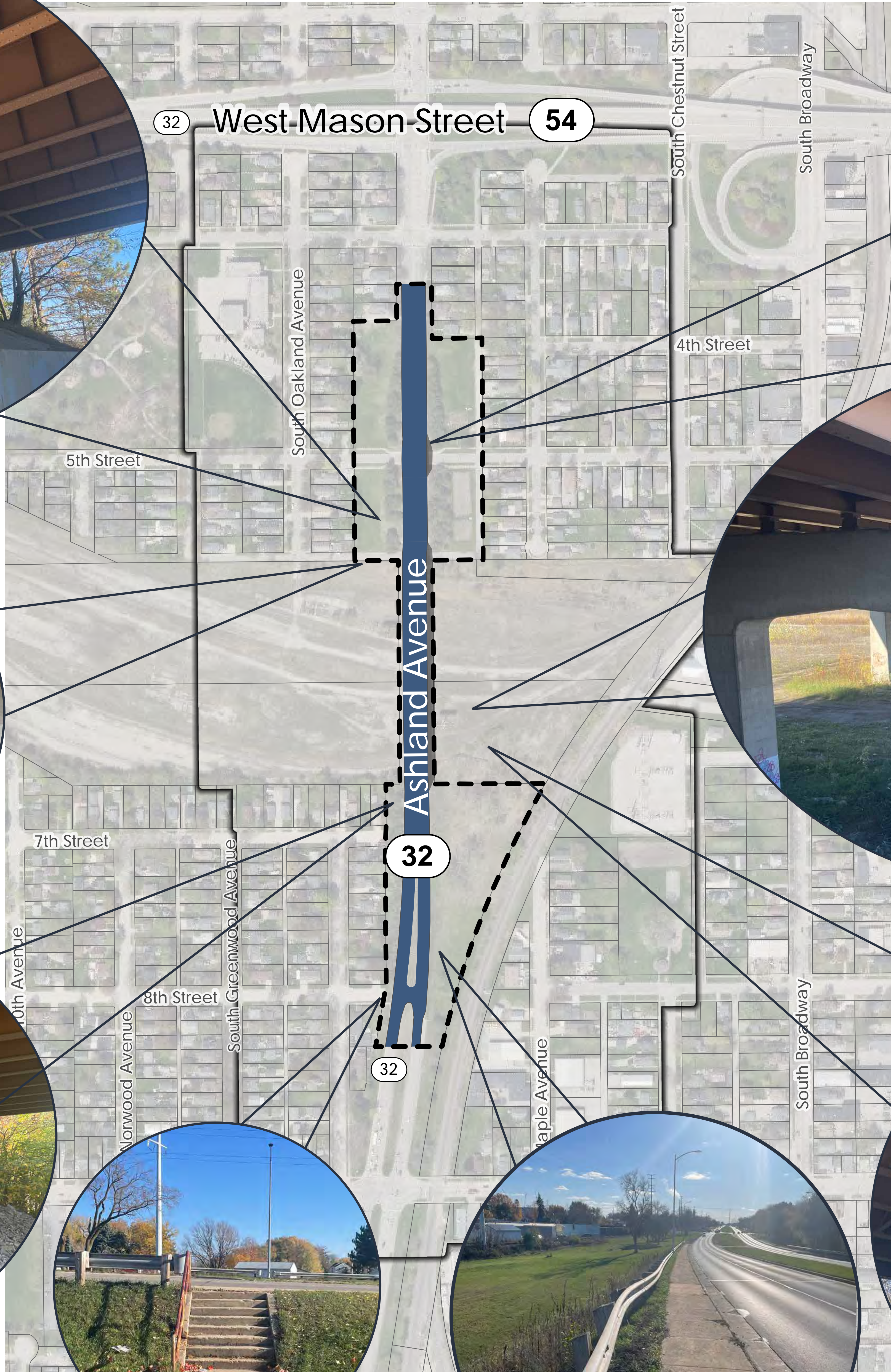

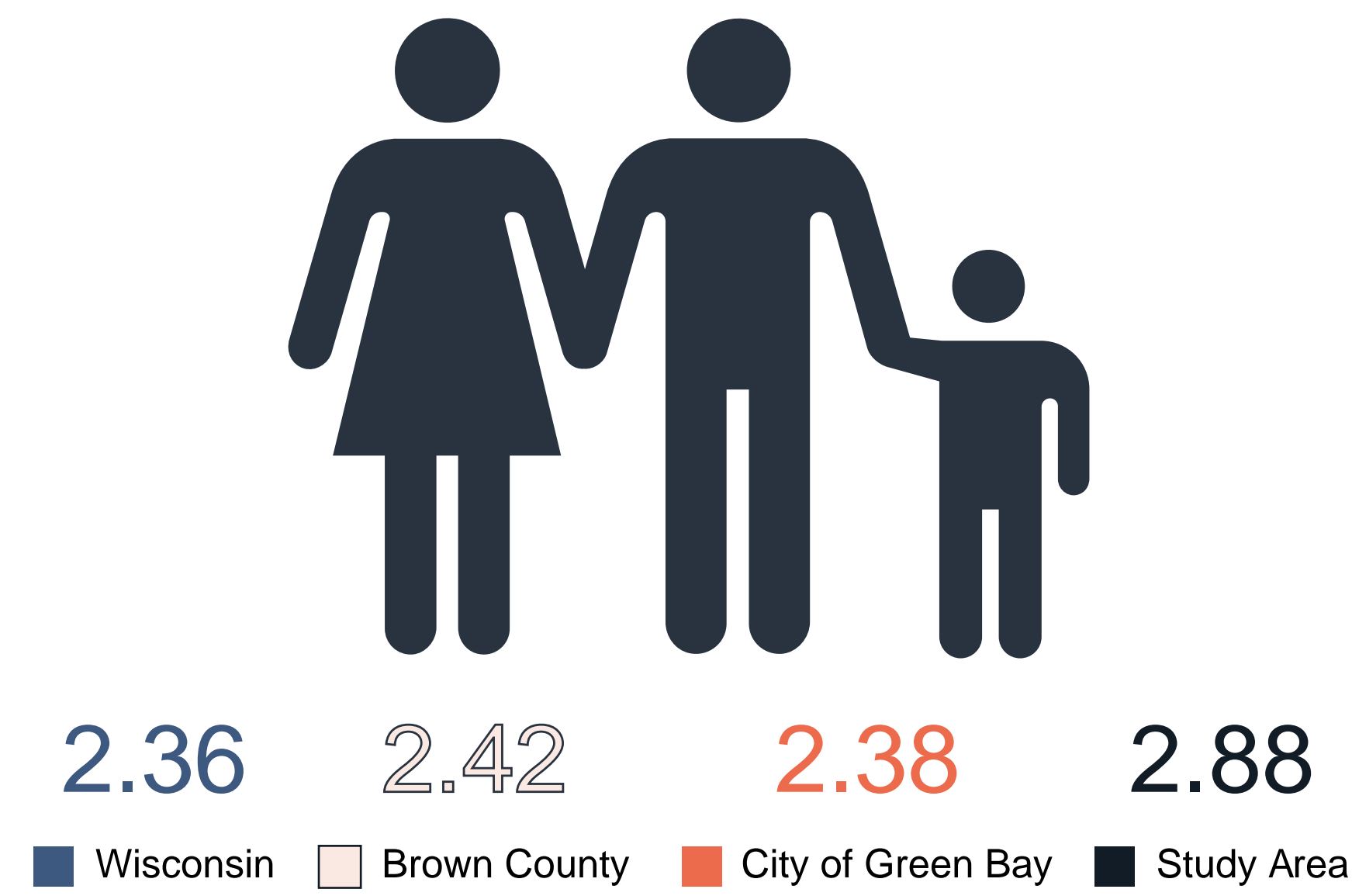

Percent of Total Households with Children

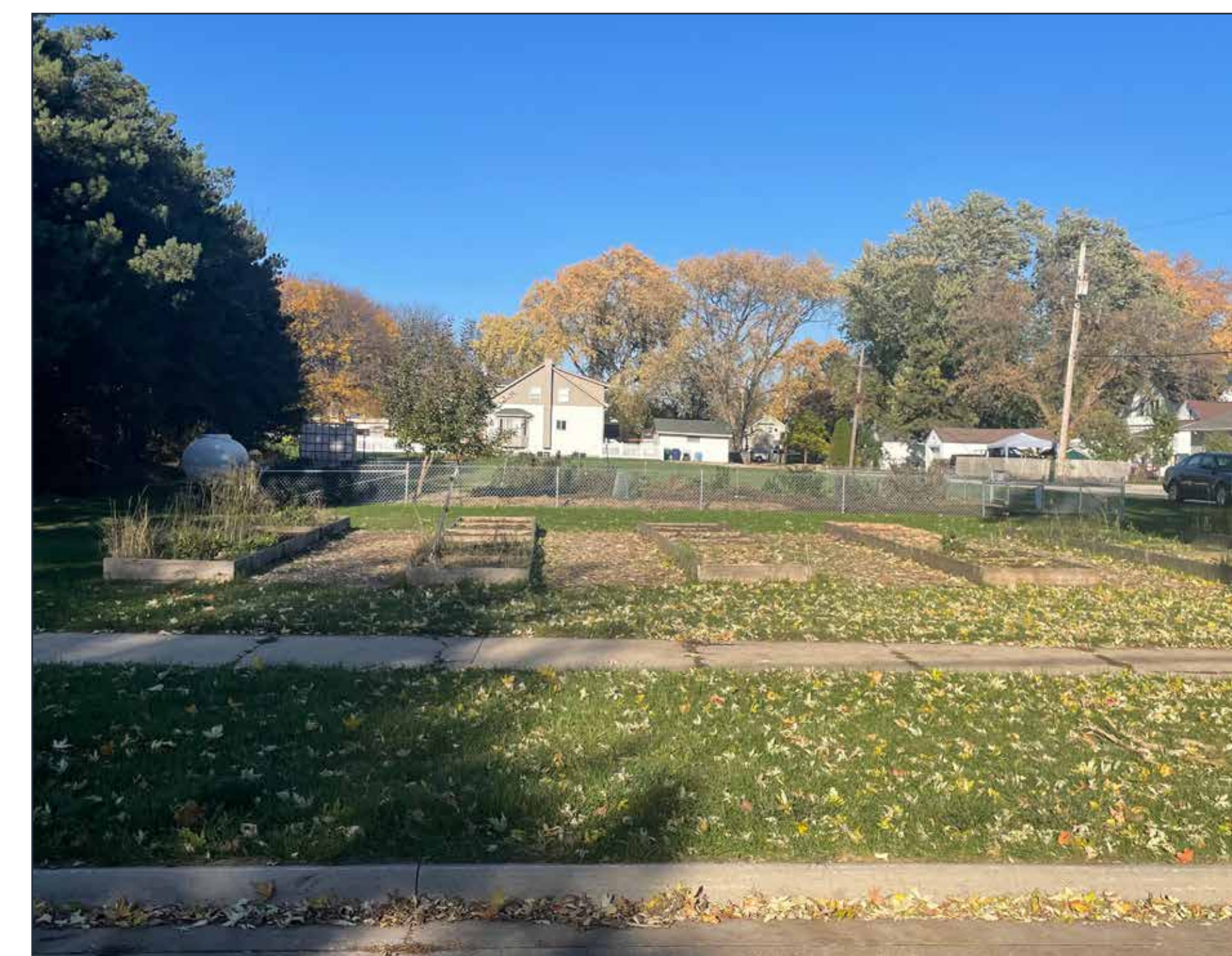
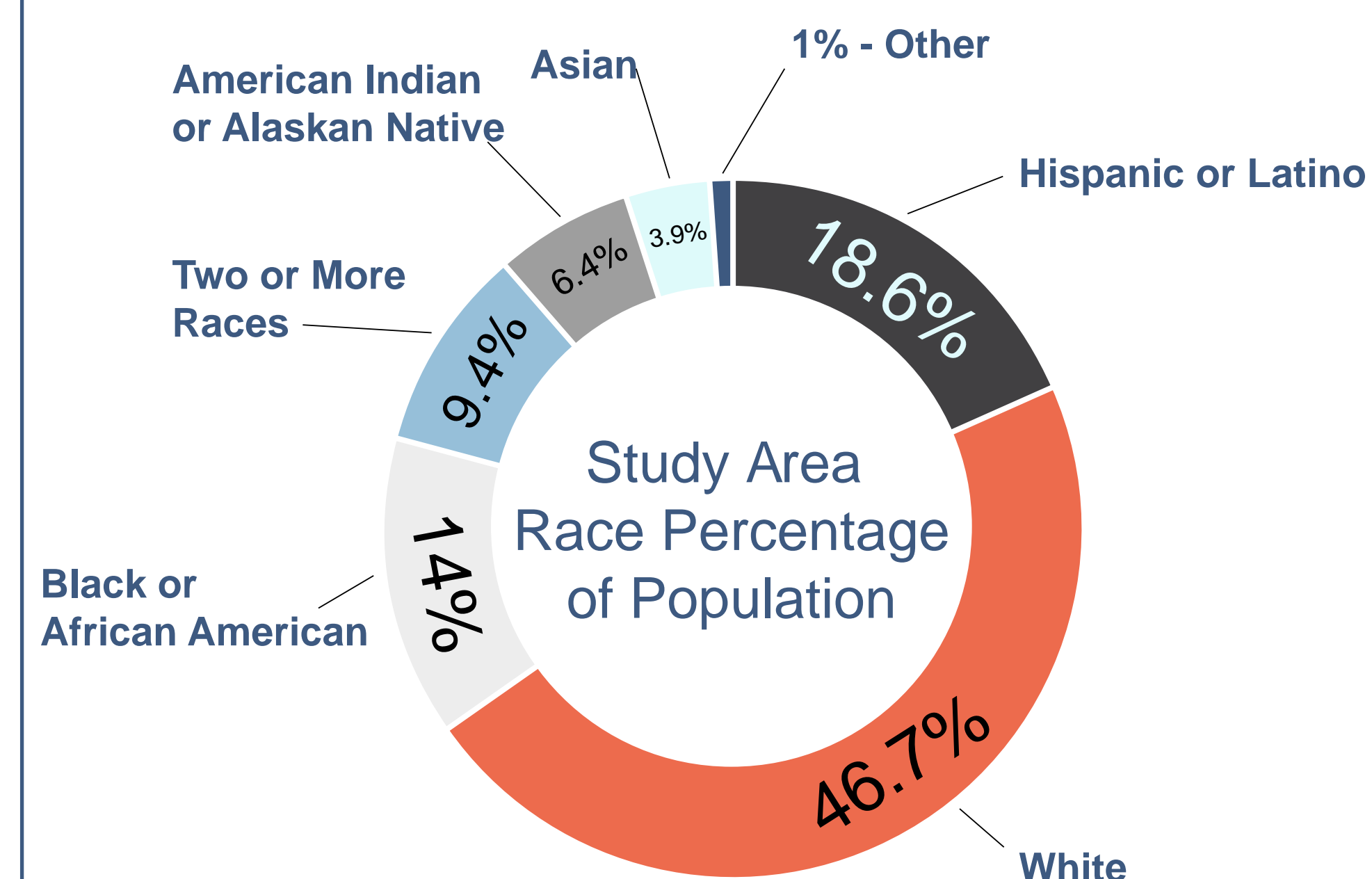
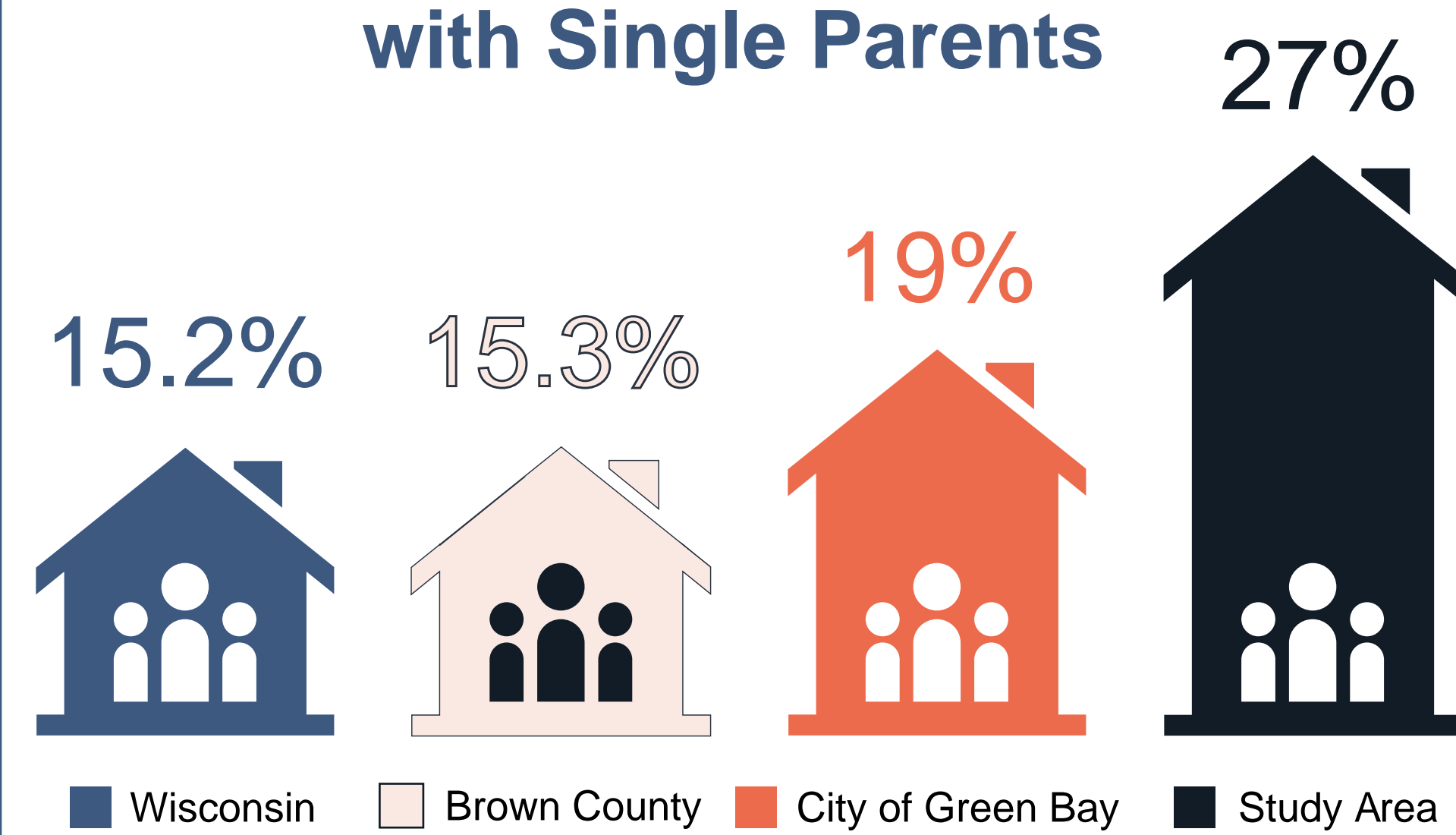

Percent of Total Households with Single Parents

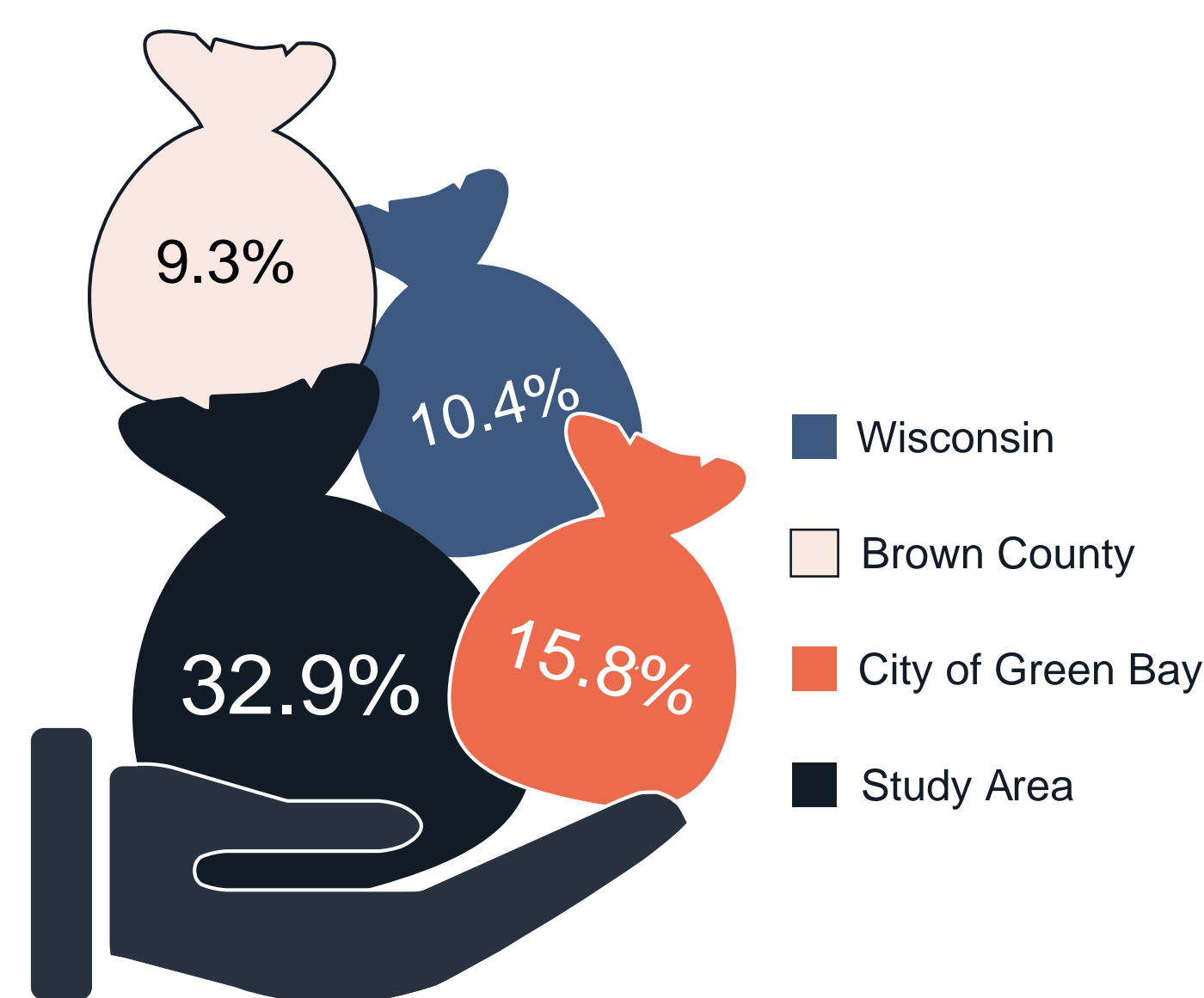

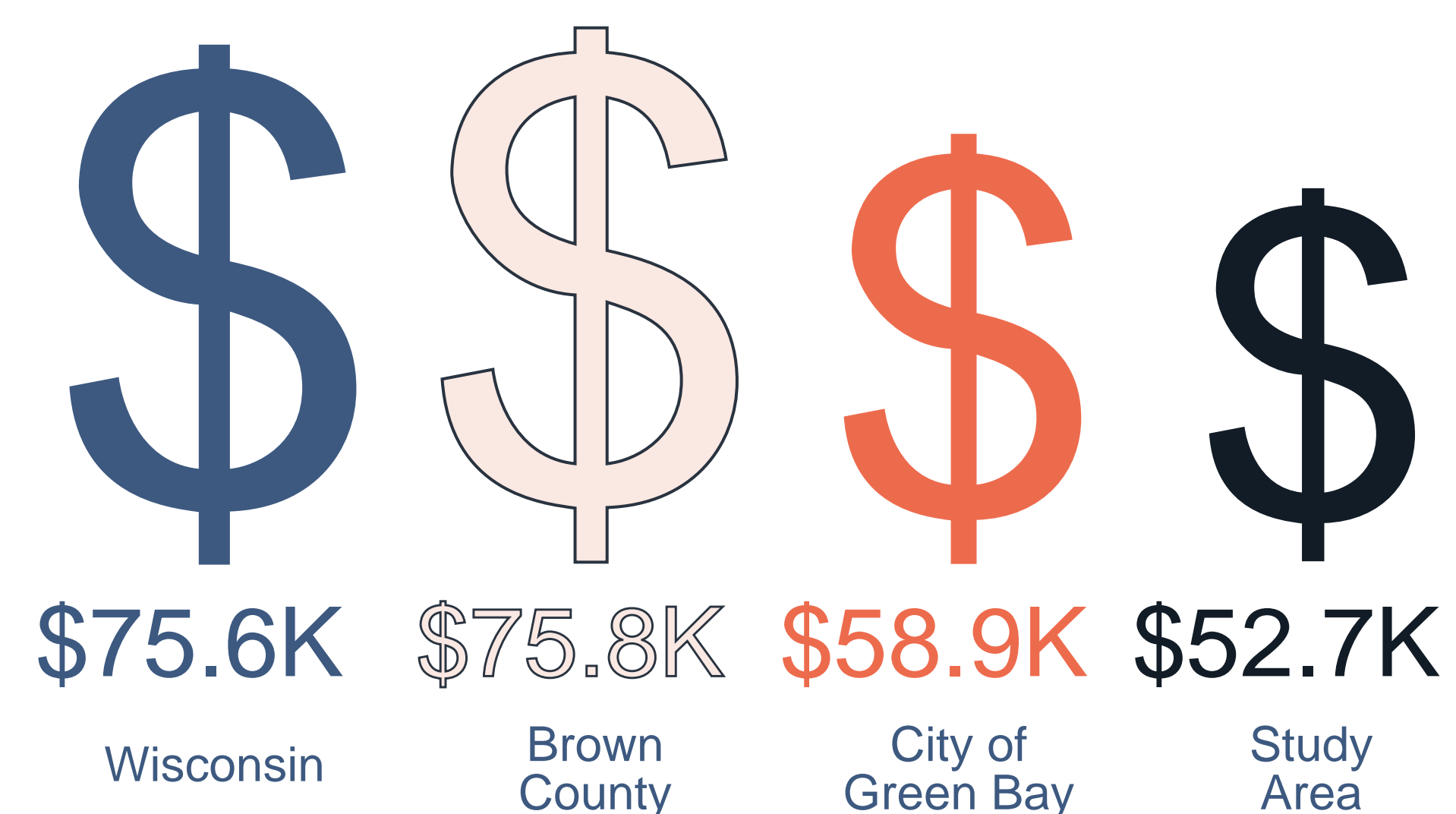
