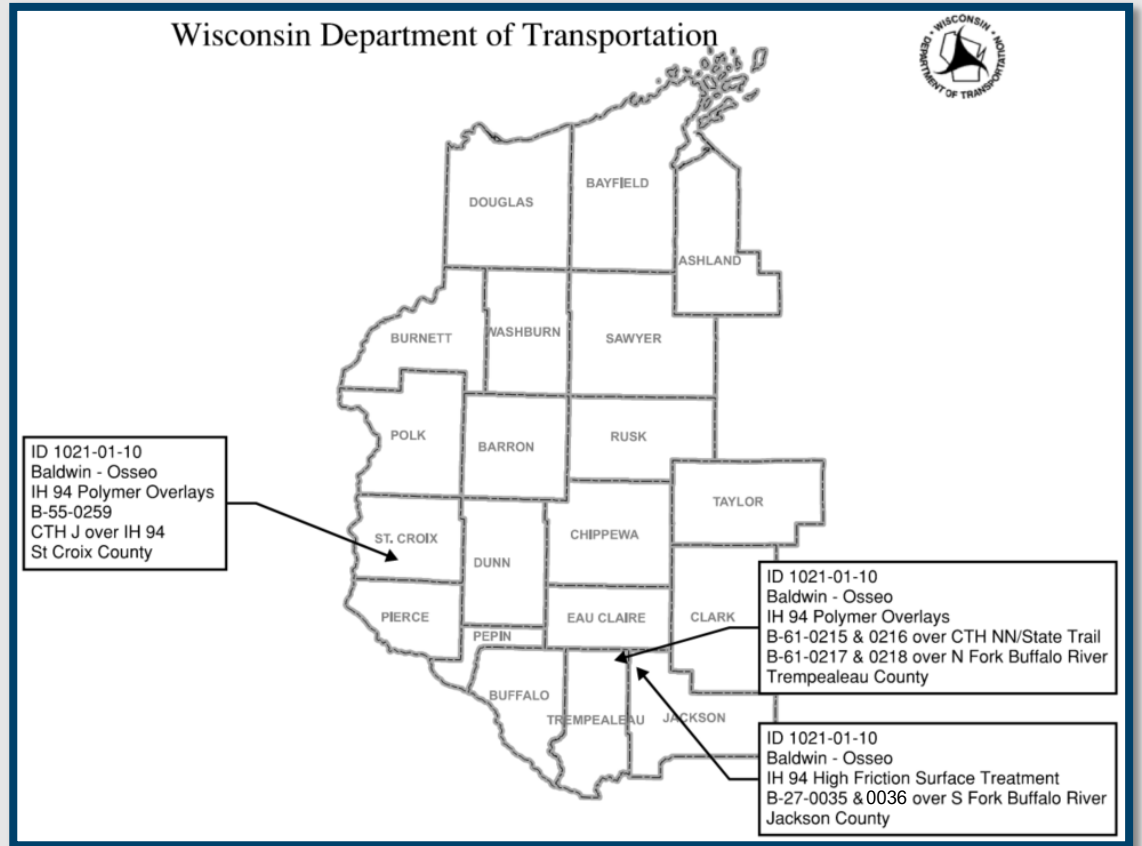

Project Location

- Jackson County

- B-27-0035 – I-94 EB over south fork of Buffalo River
- B-27-0036 – I-94 WB over south fork of Buffalo River
 - These structures are southeast of Osseo.

- St. Croix County

- B-55-0259 – County J over I-94
 - This structure is southeast of Roberts.



Project Location

- Trempealeau County
 - B-61-0215 – I-94 EB over County NN
 - B-61-0216 – I-94 WB over County NN
 - B-61-0217 – I-94 EB over north fork of Buffalo River
 - B-61-0218 – I-94 WB over north fork of Buffalo River
 - These structures are just north of Osseo.



Purpose and Need

- Purpose of the project:
 - Protect and extend life of concrete bridge decks
- Need for the project:
 - Heavy traffic deteriorating bare bridge decks



Proposed Improvements

Jackson County Structures

- Clean and make repairs on existing concrete bridge decks
- Add a high-friction surface treatment on bridge decks



Proposed Improvements

St. Croix and Trempealeau County Structures

- Clean and make repairs on existing concrete bridge decks
- Add a thin polymer overlay on bridge decks



Traffic Control

I-94 will remain open to traffic, but motorists will encounter:

- Traffic lane closures with flagging operations on County J.
- Single-lane closures during off-peak travel times on I-94.
- A temporary 55-mph speed limit will be implemented on I-94 in the work zone.



Schedule

- Preliminary design began: November 2023
- Public input solicitation: Spring 2025
- Preliminary design and environmental process complete: July 2027
- Final plan submittal: July 2027
- Construction: 2028
