Purpose of handout

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of developing plans for proposed improvements in Dunn County on US 12 from Princeton Drive to WIS 29 and on WIS 40 from US 12 to County M. The purpose of this handout is to provide information regarding the proposed project, describe the potential impacts it would have on the community and offer an opportunity for public comment.


Purpose and need for roadway improvements

The purpose of the proposed project is to make sure these segments of US 12 and WIS 40 continue to carry traffic safely by eliminating deficient road features.

The need for the project is due to the roadway deficiencies, deteriorating culvert pipes, cub ramp deficiencies, and safety.

Project location

US 12 and WIS 40 in Dunn County



Anticipated benefits

- Extends life of pavement
- Improves roadway safety
- Eliminates need for future maintenance costs saving taxpayer dollars in the future

Proposed improvements

This is a rehabilitation-level project. Proposed improvements include:

- Milling 2.25 inches of existing asphalt and paving 3.25 inches of hot-mix asphalt in rural areas
- Milling 3.25 inches of existing asphalt and paving 3.25 inches of hot-mix asphalt in urban areas
- Replacing joints on the Eighteen Mile Creek Bridge in village of Colfax
- Placing centerline rumble strips in rural areas
- Replacing cross culverts, along with sidewalk curb ramps and the railroad crossing in the village of Colfax

Traffic impacts

During most construction operations, motorists will encounter single-lane closures controlled by flagging on US 12 and WIS 40. During the railroad crossing replacement, WIS 40 will be detoured via 5th Avenue, Dunn Street and East Railroad Avenue for one week.

Real Estate

In the village of Colfax, right of way and temporary limited easements is being acquired for pedestrian curb ramp replacements.

Schedule

Public involvement process: February 2025

Final plan submittal: Aug. 1, 2025

Construction: 2026
