Bridge Rehabilitation Project Trempealeau County

Spring/Summer 2025



Built in 1989, the bridge that carries US 53 over a branch of the north fork of Beaver Creek needs rehabilitation to address structural deficiencies and make sure the bridge continues to carry traffic safely for years to come.

WisDOT is proposing to:


- Replace the concrete bridge deck
- Replace the concrete parapet
- Reconstruct approximately 600 feet of asphalt on both sides of the structure
- Install guardrail on all quadrants of the roadway approaches

Traffic Impacts

During construction, US 53 will remain open to construction, but motorists will encounter:

A single-lane traffic at the bridge controlled by temporary traffic signals.

- 2025-26: Preliminary project design and environmental document completion
- 2027: Final plan submittal in February
- 2028: Construction
