Purpose of Public Involvement

 - Identified needs
 - Proposed improvements
 - Traffic control
 - Real estate needs





Project Location

- WIS 70
 - County B West east of Spooner in Washburn County to WIS 27 North northeast of Stone Lake in Sawyer County

















Project Needs

- The following project needs have been identified:
 - Existing WIS 70 asphalt pavement shows signs of deterioration.
 - Sidewalk curb ramps do not meet current Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
 - Outdated guardrail requires adjustment or replacement to become compliant.
 - Existing culverts are deteriorating and nearing the end of their service lives.
 - Pavement markings are fading throughout the corridor.





















Proposed Improvements

- Along the 5.7-mile segment of WIS 70, WisDOT is proposing to:
 - Resurface the pavement.
 - Adjust and/or replace guardrail sections.
 - Upgrade curb ramps to meet ADA standards.
 - Repair or replace culverts.
 - Place new pavement markings.









Proposed Traffic Impacts

- During construction, work will be staged to help minimize traffic impacts, but there will be:
 - Single-lane and shoulder closures controlled by flaggers.
 - Temporary pedestrian accommodations during curb ramp work.
 - Temporary driveway closures; although, local, business and emergency access will be maintained.





Real Estate Needs and Access Modifications

- Both real estate needs and access, or driveway, modifications are still being evaluated.
 - Limited real estate needs are expected for curb ramp improvements and associated grading, and minor regrading at culvert ends.
 - Access, or driveways, will be reviewed as standard policy; however, project staff currently don't anticipate any modifications.





Next Steps

- Public involvement April/May 2025
- Final environmental document May/June 2025
- Final plan submittal May 2031
 - Could occur as early as May 2028
- Construction Summer 2032
 - Could occur as early as summer 2032
 - Estimated to take two months to complete
