
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Project Overview

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface 1.2 miles of WIS 175 in Milwaukee County. The purpose of this project is to improve pavement condition and ride quality, assess multimodal accommodations, update traffic signal equipment, and address safety concerns along the corridor.

Proposed Improvements:

- · Remove asphalt and replace with new asphalt
- Joint and crack repair to the underlying concrete
- Curb bump outs at intersections
- Replace traffic signals
- Add bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

Schedule

This project is currently in design. Construction is anticipated to **start in Spring of 2029**.

Traffic Impacts

Staging has yet to be determined however one lane of traffic in each direction will likely remain open during construction. Short term closures in spot locations may be required for some construction operations but access to local residences and businesses will be maintained. Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will provide advance notice to homeowners and businesses before closing any driveway with adequate time to develop alternative arrangements.

Temporary pedestrian accommodations, along with proper signing to direct pedestrians around work areas, will be provided during construction. Temporary parking restrictions removing parking along WIS 175 will be in place during construction. Milwaukee County Transit buses will remain in service during construction.

Real Estate

Temporary and permanent real estate acquisition is anticipated on this project. Temporary impacts are anticipated for curb ramp improvements, signal improvements, and possible access point closures. Permanent impacts are anticipated for new sidewalk addition. The amount of real estate required for this project is unknown at this time. Property owners will be notified of real estate acquisitions as the project advances in the design process. WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in November 2026.
