WIS 175 Improvement Project - WIS 60 to N. Maple Avenue

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to make improvements to 1.25 miles of WIS 175 in Washington County.

Proposed Improvements:

- Mill and overlay roadway surface
- Replace curb ramps to meet current WisDOT and ADA standards
- Replace storm sewer in select locations
- Improve signing and pavement markings

Traffic Impacts

Construction is anticipated to **start in spring of 2030**. During construction, WIS 175 will remain open to traffic. Lane closures and flagging operations are anticipated. Access to local residences and businesses will be maintained.


