WIS 181 (84th St) – Greenfield Avenue to Adler Street WIS 59 (Greenfield Ave/National Ave) – 84th Street to 56th Street

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing a pavement replacement project along WIS 181 (84th Street) from Greenfield Avenue to Adler Street; and along WIS 59 (Greenfield Ave/National Ave) from 84th Street to 56th Street in Milwaukee County. Construction on these projects is tentatively scheduled for 2029 and 2030, as shown below.

Proposed Improvements:

- Replace roadway pavement and storm sewer.
- Replace traffic signals within project limits.
- Replace curb ramps to meet ADA standards.
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.
