Project Notification

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be hosting a public involvement meeting to present and discuss the proposed improvements for the WIS 181 pavement replacement project. This project will restore the integrity of the pavement and improve ride quality.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 29th at Mequon City Hall located at 11333 N Cedarburg Road, Mequon, WI 53092. The meeting will be an open house format. Please stop in anytime between 6:00-7:30 p.m. to review the proposed improvements and project schedule and provide comments or questions to WisDOT staff regarding the project. All persons having an interest in the project are encouraged to attend.

Project Overview:

WisDOT is proposing a 2.2-mile pavement replacement project on WIS 181 beginning south of County Line Road and ending at Mequon Road.

The project will also include replacement of the existing traffic signals at Donges Bay Road, updates to all curb ramps to meet ADA standards and a new sidewalk west of WIS 181 from Donges Bay Road to Mequon Road, filling in gaps.

Traffic Impacts:

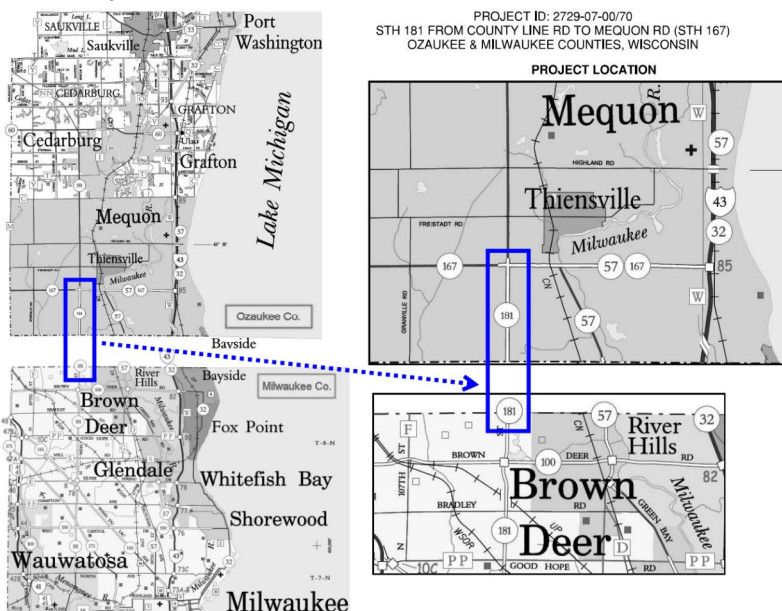
Traffic impacts are currently being determined. Access to homes and businesses will always be maintained.

Real Estate:

Minor real estate will be required to bring curb ramps into compliance with ADA requirements.

Project Schedule (Subject to change):

Preliminary design is currently underway. Final design will begin in summer of 2023. Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2026.
