Welcome to the Public Involvement Meeting (PIM) for the proposed resurfacing of US 18 from N. 106th Street to N. 66th Street in Milwaukee County. Representatives from WisDOT and the engineering design consultants are available to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns.



Project Purpose

The purpose of this project is to provide long-term improvements to the pavement, operation, and safety of the corridor for all users.

Proposed Improvements


- Replace the top four inches of the existing asphalt pavement with new asphalt.
- New shared use path along southside of US 18 from WIS 100 to I-41.
- Add dedicated bike lanes from N. 106th Street to Glenview Avenue (WIS 181).
- Curb ramp reconstruction and spot curb & gutter replacement.
- Replace traffic signal at N. 76th Street and US 18 Intersection.
- Add loops at eight existing signalized intersection and add video detection at N. 68th Street and US 18 intersection.
- Bridge (B-40-988) concrete surface repair.
- Minor right of way acquisition for curb ramps is anticipated.

No changes to the number of lanes or existing geometry are proposed.



Project Schedule

The proposed project is anticipated to start in spring of 2028, pending funding availability.

Real Estate Impacts

Real estate acquisition will begin in fall of 2025. Minimal real estate is needed and is primarily for temporary access to reconstruct curb ramps. The process will follow the WisDOT Real Estate Program Manual. Property owners will be contacted accordingly.

Traffic Impacts

During construction, US 18 between WIS 100 and N 66th Street will remain open to traffic. Outside lane will be closed during curb ramp construction. Flagging operations are anticipated. Access to local residences and business will be maintained.
