# **Project Overview**

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to replace the pavement on approximately 2 miles of WIS 32 in Milwaukee County. The purpose of this project is to provide long-term improvements to the pavement, operation, and safety of the roadway.

# **Proposed Improvements:**

- Replace the entire pavement structure
- Remove and replace all curb and gutter
- Update bike and pedestrian accommodations
  - Review possible alternatives to existing
- Improve safety and operations
  - Shorten pedestrian crossings where possible
  - Add lane arrow markings
  - Narrow up intersections
- Replace signals & Update Lighting
- Bridge work on Farwell at the Oak Leaf Trail

### **Parking Impacts:**

- Prospect:
  - Parking Spaces existing 461, proposed 448, reduction 13
- Farwell:
  - Parking Spaces existing 480, proposed 470, reduction 10

### **Alternatives being Reviewed:**

- Transit-Only lanes
- Off-street bike accommodations

### Schedule

This project is currently in preliminary design. Construction is anticipated to start in Spring of 2032 but could start as early as Spring of 2031 pending available funding.


**Preliminary Design Final Design** Construction 2024-2026 2026-2030 2031 OR 2032
