The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is hosting a public involvement meeting for a proposed curb ramp improvement project in the city of West Bend, Washington County. The curb ramps are located along WIS 144 and WIS 33.


The purpose of this project is to improve approximately 277 curb ramps in various locations along WIS 144 and WIS 33 to meet ADA standards.

Proposed Improvements:

- Reconstruct curb ramps that do not meet ADA standards
- Reconstruction of small areas of sidewalk and curb & gutter near curb ramp locations.

Construction is anticipated to start in 2026.
