Purpose of the meeting

The intent of this meeting is to receive public input regarding the reconstruction of various curb ramps along WIS 33 (West Washington Street) and WIS 144 (North Main Street / Barton Avenue). Public input is a vital and critical component in shaping this project. Specifically we are seeking input for the traffic control and staging aspects of the project.

The meeting will be held as an open house format. WisDOT and project team representatives will be available to review project information and answer any questions or concerns.

Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve over 200 curb ramps at various locations along WIS 33 and WIS 144. Proposed improvements include the reconstruction of deteriorating curb ramps that do not meet ADA requirements. This project will also include the reconstruction of sidewalk and curb and gutter near curb ramp locations. This corridor is important for pedestrian accessibility to local recreational areas and businesses therefore it is crucial that the curb ramps and sidewalks be updated to meet current standards.

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2026

The general traffic control concept is to keep the roadway open to traffic, restricted by lane and shoulder closures. While the curb ramps are being constructed, pedestrians would be accommodated with either temporary pedestrian facilities or pedestrian detours.

Temporary driveway closures may be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway.

Real estate

Additional right of way is being required for this project. At various locations the project will require small (approximate 10-ft wide) right of way and temporary easement acquisitions. Real estate acquisition is currently ongoing.

Property owners will be contacted in advance of construction, so the property owner can remove the encroachments from the highway right of way or obtain a permit as needed.

Project update/next steps

The following is the current anticipated schedule for the project:

Real Estate Acquisition: Concluding in fall 2025

• Final plans: Winter 2025

Construction: 2026
