I-43 Bridge Rehabilitations from N. Halyard Street to W. Capitol Drive

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to rehabilitate 11 bridges over I-43 in the City of Milwaukee. Construction is anticipated to start in Spring of 2027.

The purpose of the proposed project is to rehabilitate 11 structures over I-43 from N. Halyard Street to W. Capitol Drive in Milwaukee County.

## Proposed Improvements:

- Bridge girder painting and repairs
- Bridge deck replacements and overlays
- Bridge expansion joint, bearing and fence replacements
- Construct a new retaining wall near the Ring Street pedestrian bridge
- Pavement rehabilitation and curb ramp updates
- · Lighting and traffic signal improvements
