

92ND STREET BRIDGE OVER I-894 DESIGN STUDY JANUARY 2025



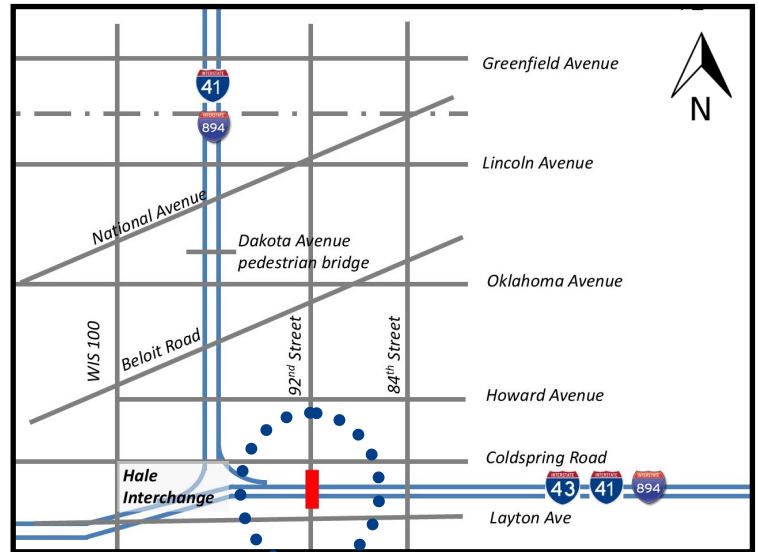
The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is initiating a study regarding the reconstruction of the 92nd Street Bridge over I-894 in Greenfield.

STUDY CONSIDERATIONS:

- **Reconstruction:** Full reconstruction of the 92nd Street Bridge over I-894 and reconstruct sections of 92nd Street which connect to the bridge
- **Realign:** Straighten the curved section of 92nd Street which match into the bridge

WHY IS WISDOT PROPOSING TO RECONSTRUCT THE 92ND STREET BRIDGE?

- Reconstructing a bridge before it reaches a critical state is more cost-effective than addressing an emergency. Proactive investment in reconstruction avoids higher costs associated with emergency repairs.
- Reconstructing the 92nd Street Bridge over I-894 is not merely about replacing an aging structure but about prioritizing safety, supporting economic vitality, and ensuring the long-term functionality of transportation infrastructure.
