


WIS 59 National Avenue – 39th Street to 1st Street, Milwaukee County



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation and the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works are planning to improve West National Avenue from South 39th Street to South 1st Street. Roadway construction is tentatively scheduled for 2026-2027.

Pavement Replacement Project Needs:

- Improve safety
- Improve pavement ride
- Improve traffic operations
- Replace curb ramps to meet ADA compliance
- Update traffic signals



Existing Conditions:


- No additional Right-of-Way to be acquired, limiting the options for the proposed roadway configurations
- National Avenue must be able to accommodate larger vehicles (Oversized and Overweight), including the larger turning movements. These vehicles must be able to traverse through the roadway geometry.



Flex Space Possible Uses




Parts of a Sidewalk





IMPORTANCE OF ITEMS WHEN THINKING ABOUT THE FUTURE OF NATIONAL AVENUE - 2022




Survey Summary
