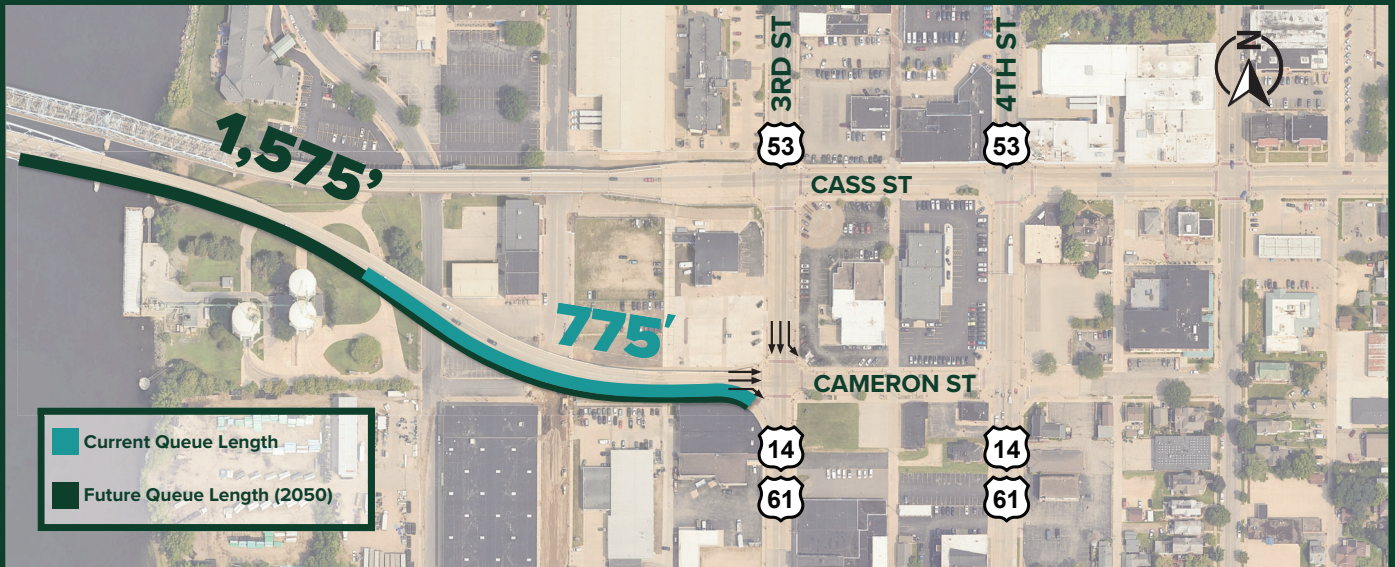

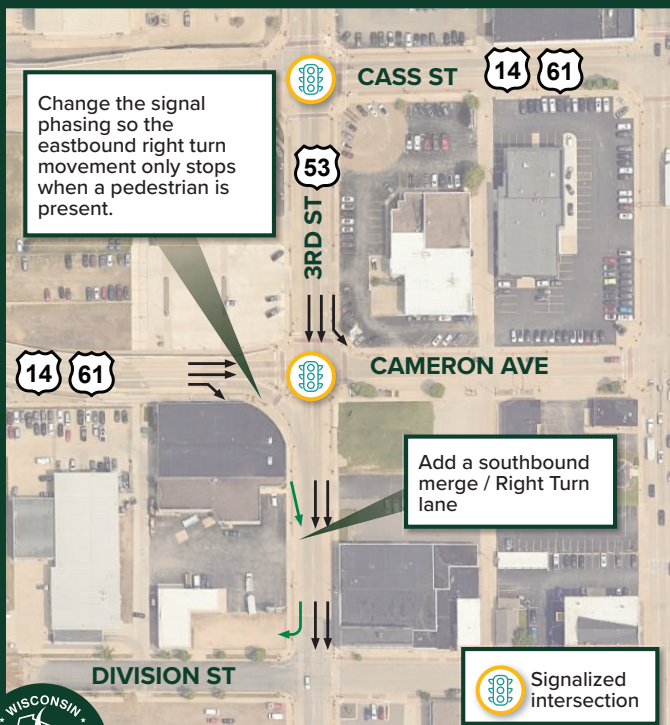
Spot Improvement Concepts: 3rd St. and Cameron St. Intersection

The **3rd St. and Cameron St. intersection** has safety and operations concerns related to lengthy queues in the eastbound right turn lane. These queues frequently spill out of the turn lane and block the through lane of traffic. Several rear-end crashes involving these right turners have occurred in recent years. **Two options are being considered to address this concern:**

Current and Future Queue Length in Eastbound Right Lane

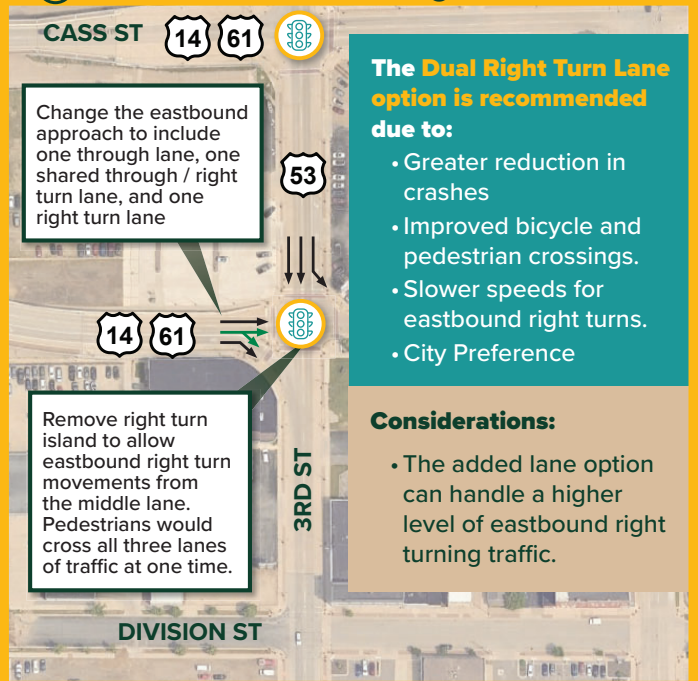


Option 1: Added Lane Option



Option 2: Dual Right Turn Option

Recommendation: Dual Right Turn Lane



The Dual Right Turn Lane option is recommended due to:

- Greater reduction in crashes
- Improved bicycle and pedestrian crossings.
- Slower speeds for eastbound right turns.
- City Preference

Considerations:

- The added lane option can handle a higher level of eastbound right turning traffic.
