

Impact Avoidance



Impacts Avoidance

During early phases of the project, environmental constraints were mapped in order to minimize potential impacts during design phases of the project. The recommended alternative has very few conflicts that would require acquisition of property or impacts to sensitive resources.





Willow Trail is an important recreation route along the La Crosse River, with access points on WIS 35. Access to the trail will be temporarily closed only on one side of WIS 35 at a time, and overall access would be improved by the recommended alternative, which adds better connections to the trail system.

Powell Park Impacts



The park is a key neighborhood open space and recreation facility. A small amount of park property would be temporarily used for construction of improved sidewalks on WIS 35, and all facilities will be restored following construction. Access for walking and biking to the park will be improved with the addition of better connections.

Corridor Wide: Curb Ramp Impacts



Curb Ramps will be updated to meet ADA standards. Curb ramp construction may require temporary or permanent access to adjacent properties.
