Purpose

The purpose of the proposed action is to preserve the ferry asset and minimize the overall life cycle cost of the operation. This can be accomplished by addressing the following needs: building deficiencies and drainage deficiencies.

Building deficiencies: The existing maintenance building no longer serves the ferry operations efficiently. The building does not have adequate storage or workspace. Some equipment and materials are currently being stored at an off-site location.


Drainage deficiencies: Ponding occurs directly south and southeast of the existing building causing damage to the site.

Project information

WisDOT is proposing to replace the existing maintenance building with a larger building to properly accommodate the needs of the ferry operations and maintenance. Additionally, the area directly adjacent to the building will be regraded for proper drainage around the new building.

The environmental, archaeological, and historical studies have begun and are anticipated to be completed in Winter 2024.
