- To obtain feedback from the public on the proposed improvements








Project Location

- Project limits: Walmart intersection, from Brendel Lane to 400 feet south of the Walmart intersection
- Project length: 0.14 miles



















Purpose and Need


- Purpose
 - Improve the US 14 and Walmart intersection safety
- Need:
 - Safety deficiency: Unsafe conditions at the intersection of US 14 and the Walmart driveway
 - This intersection has a high crash rate





Proposed Improvements


- Change left-turn lanes to offset left-turn lanes
- Install traffic signals
- Provide a connection to a future City of Viroqua roadway
- Replace existing curb ramps at two intersection corners
- Construct new curb ramps at two intersection corners







Current Conceptual Plan























Proposed Improvements


Traffic Signal Pole Example

Project Funding

- 90% Federal, 10% State
 - Change left-turn lanes to offset left-turn lanes
 - Install traffic signals
 - Replace existing curb ramps at two intersection corners
 - Construct new curb ramps at two intersection corners
- 100% Local
 - Providing a connection to a future City of Viroqua roadway





Proposed Traffic Impacts

- During construction, US 14 will remain open to traffic.
 - Motorists can expect single lane and shoulder closures and flagging operations.
 - Pavement markings may be temporarily changed to close existing turn lanes. Traffic would be able to turn from the adjacent through lanes.
 - Pavement markings may be temporarily changed to shift the northbound and southbound through lanes within the roadway.
 - During the day, the Walmart driveway may be reduced to one-lane with flaggers to construct curb ramps and traffic signal pole foundations.





Proposed Traffic Impacts

- During construction, US 14 will remain open to traffic.
 - Driveways and businesses, including Walmart, will be accessible during construction with short disruptions to access (less than 15 minutes).
 - Advanced notification of any temporary disruptions will be provided by construction staff.
 - Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
- Temporary pedestrian detours will be posted.





Real Estate Needs

 No real estate acquisition is anticipated for the proposed improvements.





Project Schedule

- September 29 to October 29, 2025: Virtual Public Involvement
 - Project Website + Comment Period
- December 2025: Final environmental document
- September 2026: Project information notice mailed to stakeholders providing a project update
- October 2026: Final plans, specifications, and estimate submittal
- 2027: Construction
