

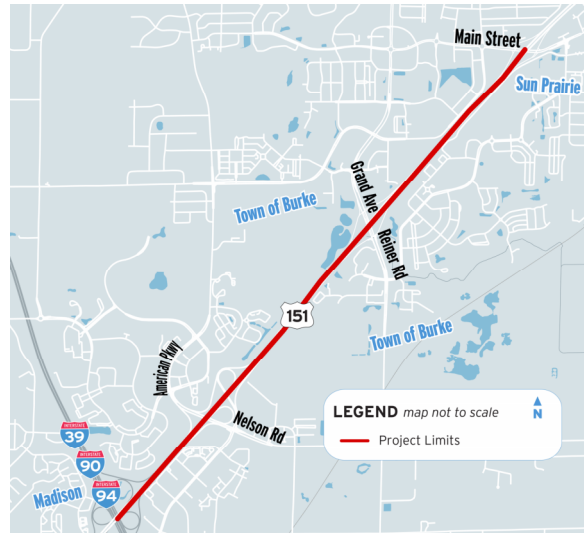


Public Involvement Meeting

Purpose

The purpose of this public involvement meeting is to present design concepts for the proposed improvement along US 151, address impacts to traffic during construction and obtain your input.



Project Information

The purpose of this project is to provide safe vehicular travel and optimally extend the service life of the roadway on US 151 and the American Parkway and Reiner Road/Grand Avenue interchanges. The existing pavement in this corridor shows signs of distress and is in poor condition.

Proposed improvements include:

- US 151 Mainline
 - Concrete pavement repairs and patching
 - Asphalt mill and overlay of shoulders entire project length
 - Asphalt overlay of mainline lanes and shoulder from 0.5 miles north of American Parkway to Main Street
 - Guardrail replacement north of American Parkway
- American Parkway Interchange Ramps
 - Concrete pavement repairs and patching
 - Asphalt mill and overlay of shoulders
 - Guardrail replacement
 - Curb ramp replacement
- Reiner Road/Grand Avenue Interchange Ramps
 - Concrete pavement repairs and patching
 - Asphalt mill and overlay of shoulders
 - Installation of additional signal loop (Improvement at NB Main Street Exit Ramp as well)
 - Curb ramp replacement

- Structure Improvements – American Parkway and Reiner Road/Grand Avenue Bridges
 - Minor structure repairs

An environmental document is being prepared to address potential impacts to environmental resources along the project corridor.

Proposed Traffic Impacts

Construction is scheduled for 2029. The project will likely take the entire construction season.

During construction, traffic along US 151 will require lane closures during overnight and off-peak hours. Motorists can expect overnight staged ramp closures of the interchange ramps at American Parkway and Reiner Road/Grand Avenue to complete concrete patching and shoulder improvements. Traffic delays are expected during overnight and off peak-hours for the duration of the construction season on US 151.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction along American Parkway and Reiner Road/Grand Avenue for short term structure repairs and curb ramp replacements.

Pedestrians can expect temporary curb ramps and sidewalk to bypass construction while curb ramps are being replaced along American Parkway and Reiner Road/Grand Avenue.

Real Estate

No real estate acquisition is anticipated at this time.
