US 151 Project Limits

- Madison to Sun Prairie, I-39/90/94 to Main Street



US 151 Project Needs

- The following project needs have been identified:
 - Pavement deterioration
 - Structure repairs
 - Pedestrian curb ramp deficiencies
 - Pedestrian push button deficiencies
 - Drainage maintenance



US 151 Project Information

- The following improvements are proposed
 - Concrete pavement repairs
 - Asphalt overlay north section
 - Mill and overlay asphalt shoulders
 - Curb ramp replacement
 - Replace guardrail in overlay area and remove nonstandard end treatments
 - Pipe and ditch cleaning
 - Structure rehabilitation work



US 151 Proposed Traffic Impacts

- US 151 Mainline
 - Lane closures during non-peak hours
- US 151 Ramps
 - Ramp closures during overnight hours
- Sidewalks
 - Detours (across the street) and temporary surfaces
