

US 51 Corridor Overview



- 18.1 miles
- Split into 11 construction projects
- Four areas
 - E. of Stoughton I-39/90 to Spring Road
 - Stoughton Spring Road to Roby Road
 - Rural Roby Road to Exchange Street
 - McFarland Exchange Street to Terminal **Drive/Voges Road**

















Current Construction Projects



- Spring Road to Fifth Street
 - Closed roadway
 - Detour posted on I-39/90
- Larson Beach Road to Voges Road/Terminal Drive
 - US 51 is open to traffic



















2026 Construction

- South Harrison Street to South Quam Drive
- Lake Kegonsa Road to Charles Lane
- Tower Road to Exchange Street
- Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road
















Upcoming Construction – Project Information Harrison Street to Hoel Avenue

- Section highlights
 - Harrison Street to Kings Lynn Road:
 - Reconstruct to urban cross section with Two-Way-Left-Turn-Lane (TWLTL)
 - Page Street to Harrison Street will be re-striped until future project will reconstruct it
 - Kings Lynn Road to Hoel Avenue: Reconstruct existing 4-lane urban section
 - New 10 foot sidewalk north of US 51 between Gjertson Street and Hoel Avenue














Upcoming Construction – Project Information Jackson Street to County B (east)


- Section highlights
 - Reconstruct from 2-lane to 4-lane divided highway with a raised median
 - New 10-foot sidewalk on both sides of US 51
 - Jackson Street to Rutland Dunn Townline Road
 - Continuous street lighting
 - Reconstruct Hults Road as right-in/right-out from Jackson Street







Hults Road Intersection




















Upcoming Construction – Project Information Jackson Street to County B (east)

- Section highlights (continued)
 - Dual-lane roundabout at Rutland-Dunn Townline Road intersection
 - Dual-lane roundabout at County B (east) intersection
 - New pedestrian underpass north of Rutland-Dunn Townline Road
 - Posted speed limit reduction from 55 to 35 mph








Upcoming Construction – Project Information County B (east) to S Quam Drive

- Section highlights
 - Reconstruct to 2-lane rural section with raised median
 - One 12-foot travel lane in each direction
 - 30-foot (typical) median including curb and gutter
 - 10-foot shoulders including 6-foot asphalt

















Harrison Street to S Quam Drive: All Stages

- Traffic
 - Traffic is reduced to single lane in each direction.
 - Access to businesses and residences will be maintained
 - Pedestrians will have access, but may be detoured to different sides of the street













Harrison Street to S Quam Drive: Stage 1 (2026)

- Construction
 - Construct temporary pavement
- Traffic
 - Night-time closures for culvert crossings.
 - All intersections remain open to US 51















Harrison Street to S Quam Drive: Stage 2 (2026)

- Construction
 - Construct southbound lanes
- Traffic
 - Intermittent sideroad closures from Harrison Street to Kings Lynn Road
 - Hoel Avenue, WIS 138 (north), Jackson Street, Roby Road, County B (east) remain open
 - Rutland-Dunn Townline Road: Closed to traffic
 - Greenbriar Drive: Right-in/right-out access to US 51













Harrison Street to S Quam Drive: Stage 3 (2026)

- Construction
 - Construct northbound lanes
- Traffic
 - Intermittent sideroad closures from Harrison Street to Kings Lynn Road
 - Hoel Avenue, WIS 138 (north), Jackson Street, Roby Road, County B (east) remain open
 - County B (east) will have a temporary signal
 - Rutland-Dunn Townline Road: Right-in/right-out access to US 51
 - Greenbriar Drive: Closed to traffic
 - Intermittent sideroad closures at S. Brooklyn Drive and S. Quam Drive

















Harrison Street to S Quam Drive: Stage 4 (2026)

Construction

- Construct remaining, medians, curb and gutter and sidewalk
- Construct left-turn lanes at Jackson Street

Traffic

- Intermittent intersection closures from Harrison Street to Kings Lynn Road
- Jackson Street: Right-in/right-out access to US 51















Lake Kegonsa Road to Charles Lane: (2026)

- Construction
 - Construct early-fill on both sides of the highway
- Traffic
 - US 51 remains open to traffic
 - Temporary concrete barrier to remain in place over Winter 2026-2027




















Upcoming Construction – Project Information Tower Road to Exchange Street

Reconstruct to 4-lane rural section with raised median




- Two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction
- 10-foot raised median including curb and gutter
- 10-foot shoulders including 6-foot asphalt paved for bicycle accommodations





Tower Road to Exchange Street

- Dual-lane roundabout at Tower Road intersection
- Dual-lane roundabout at Exchange Street intersection
- Posted speed limit reduction from 55 to 40 mph







Tower Road to Exchange Street: All stages

- Traffic
 - Traffic is reduced to single lane in each direction
 - Access to businesses and residences will be maintained





Tower Road to Exchange Street: Stage 1 (2026)

- Construction
 - Temporary pavement along west side of US 51.
- Traffic
 - US 51: Reduced to a single lane in the southbound direction (inside lane).
 - Tower Road: Open to traffic.
 - Exchange Street: Open to traffic.















Upcoming Construction – Anticipated Construction Impacts Tower Road to Exchange Street: Stage 2 (2026)

- Construction
 - US 51 northbound pavement and Exchange Street
- Traffic
 - US 51: Single lane in each direction on existing southbound pavement and temporary widening.
 - Tower Road: Open to traffic.
 - Exchange Street: Closed to traffic; local business access only.













Tower Road to Exchange Street: Stage 3 (2026)


- Construction
 - US 51 southbound pavement and Tower Road
- Traffic
 - US 51: Single lane in each direction on new northbound pavement and adjacent temporary widening.
 - Tower Road: Single lane in each direction. Short-term closure required to complete connection to existing pavement.
 - Exchange Street: Open to traffic.

















Tower Road to Exchange Street: Stage 4 (2026)

- Construction
 - Median
- Traffic
 - US 51: Single lane in each direction outside northbound and southbound travel lanes.
 - Tower Road Roundabout: Open to traffic.
 - Exchange Street Roundabout: Open to traffic.













Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road







Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road

- Reconstruct existing 4-lane urban section
- Intersection improvements
- Replace and lengthen Yahara River bridge
- New pedestrian underpass at Yahara River bridge
- Improve pedestrian accommodations
- Numerous improvements within Babcock Park





Exchange St to Larson Beach Rd: Stage 1 (Fall 2026)

- Construction
 - Replace sanitary sewer crossings of the Yahara River
 - Remove existing islands and install temporary pavement
- Traffic
 - US 51 reduced to single lane in each direction
 - All intersections remain open
 - Access to businesses and residences will be maintained

















Winter 2026 and 2027 Construction

- South Quam Drive to County B/AB
- County B/AB to Tower Road
- Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road



















Winter 2026 and 2027 Construction with advanceable

- South Quam Drive to County B/AB
- County B/AB to Tower Road
- Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road
- 5th Street to S Harrison Street



















Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road: Stage 2 (Winter 2026/2027)

- Construction
 - Remove and replace Yahara River bridge
 - Construct underground utilities (storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water)
 - Replace large culvert at Farwell Street intersection
- Traffic
 - US 51 closed from Exchange Street to Yahara Drive (Detour)
 - Local traffic (Access to businesses and residences)
 - US 51 reduced to single lane in each direction from Yahara Drive to Larson Beach Road













- 30-foot (typical) median including curb and gutter
- 10-foot shoulders including 6-foot asphalt paved for bicycle accommodations















Upcoming Construction – Project Information


South Quam Drive to County B/AB: Project Highlights

- Rural intersection improvements
 - Designated left-turn lanes
 - Slotted left-turn lane at Halverson Road and Lake Kegonsa Road
 - Designated right-turn lanes
 - Designated bike lane markings
- Reconstruct pedestrian underpass south of Charles Lane





Upcoming Construction - 2027 Construction County B/AB to Tower Road















County B/AB to Tower Road

Reconstruct 2-lane rural section



- One 12-foot travel lane in each direction
- 10-foot shoulders including 6-foot asphalt paved for bicycle accommodations













Upcoming Construction - Proposed Information

County B/AB to Tower Road

- Dyreson Road Intersection Improvements
 - Cul de sac the south leg
 - Realign the north leg
- Single-lane roundabout at Mahoney Road intersection
- New backage road off Mahoney Road
- Terrestrial crossing(s) in marsh area south of Mahoney Road





Upcoming Construction - 2027 Construction Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road







Upcoming Construction – Anticipated Construction Impacts

Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road: Stage 3 (Summer 2027)

- Construction
 - Continue finishing Yahara River bridge and retaining walls
 - US 51 NB pavement
- Traffic
 - US 51 reduced to single lane in each direction
 - Some short term staggered closures on sideroads
 - Burma Road and Yahara Drive intersections alternately closed













Upcoming Construction – Anticipated Construction Impacts

Exchange Street to Larson Beach Road: Stage 4 (Summer/Fall 2027)

- Construction
 - Continue finishing Yahara River bridge and retaining walls
 - US 51 SB pavement
- Traffic
 - US 51 reduced to single lane in each direction
 - Some short term staggered closures of sideroads















Upcoming Construction - Project Detour Exchange Street to Yahara Drive: Spring 2027 to Summer 2027



Note: Contractor required to maintain access to residents and businesses during construction.

- -S Quam Dr to the south will be open to local traffic
- -County B/AB roundabout will be open to traffic
- -Tower Rd to Exchange Street wil be open to local traffic



















Upcoming Construction - Project Detour County B/AB to Tower Road: Summer 2027 to Fall 2027



Note: Contractor required t maintain access to residents and businesses during construction.

- -S Quam Dr to the south will be open to local traffic
- -County B/AB roundabout will be open to traffic
- -Mahoney Rd to the north will be open to local traffic


















Upcoming Construction - Project Detour Bay View Heights – Access Sequencing (2027)

- Future on-site meetings will be held with the Bay View Heights community













Other projects in the area

- US 14 City of Fitchburg limits, Dane County
 - Scheduled for construction in 2029. If funding becomes available, construction could be advanced as early as 2026
 - Construction not anticipated to occur in 2027
- WIS 138 WIS 59 to Milwaukee Street, Dane/Rock counties
 - Scheduled for construction in 2030
 - Advanceable to 2029 (if US 51 is not under construction)
